In Australia 50% of people aged over 65 have a disability [source: ABS 2019b]. Without appropriate equipment, accessing a pool or spa can be difficult or impossible for many people.

Swimming is one of Australia's favourite pastimes. Splashing around in the water with friends and family not only has physical benefits but is great for our social and emotional wellbeing and inclusion. Sadly, the delight of swimming is out of reach for millions of people who are unable to get in and out of the water safely.

Fortunately, the Building Code of Australia mandates, for new or renovated pools, that swimming pools must have at least one of the following:

40m perimeter swimming pool:

- An accessible water entry/exit by means of a fixed or movable ramp and an aquatic wheelchair
- A zero depth entry at a maximum gradient of 1:14
- A swimming pool lift capable of a platform and an aquatic wheelchair or
- A sling-style swimming pool lift

70m perimeter swimming pool:

 An accessible water entry/exit by means of a fixed or movable ramp and an aquatic wheelchair

• A zero depth entry at a maximum gradient of 1:14

"In the water Ace is just like everybody else"



The Pelican Pool and Spa Hoist helps people living with a disability get in and out of a swimming pool safely.

"When Ace swims he has this freedom and you can see the pure joy that it gives him," says his mum Bianca who has been watching her son thrive in the pool since he was little.

Ace is one of the many children across Australia who have benefited from Para Mobility's Pelican Pool and Spa Hoist. The hoist gives safe access to public and home pools without manual lifting.

"When Ace was little I could carry him on my hip so it was easier to get him in and out of the local pool," says Bianca. "But as Ace got older and heavier, it became harder to get him into the water. We'd have to lay him down on the ground and it wasn't safe or dignified."

"Dignity" is a word Bianca uses a lot when she speaks of the benefits of Para Mobility's pool hoist. "I want Ace to have all the same experiences and opportunities as any other child," she says. "Being able to provide for your child, being able to help them function in a world where they are not the norm is empowering." "When he first started, Ace couldn't use both of his arms to swim, but he was so determined to do everything the other kids were doing," says NDIS support worker, Kat Roberts. "It's through his determination and swimming that Ace has learned to find the pathways in both his arms."

Swimming has also helped him build other capabilities from feeding himself to using a voice output device and it's such an inclusive activity.

"I really believe swimming has helped him in so many other areas of his life from his physical capabilities to his mental health," she says.

"He tells us constantly he wants to go swimming, and having the Pelican hoist means he can continue to do this which is so important to him and to us."

Managing five pool at the Ryde Aquatic Centre is no small feat, just ask Andrew whose job it is to make sure the facilities are safe, accessible and enjoyable for everyone in their local community.
