Paper cups with a plastic lining | Frozen food boxes
Styrofoam | Soft plastics including bags and lolly wrappers
Non compostable plastics | Paper towel | Wood
Pyrex glass | Food waste

ELIGIBLE CONTAINERS:

Soft drinks - cans and plastic (up to 3L) | Still or carbonated bottled water (plastic and glass up to 3L) | Small flavoured milk (cardboard and plastic up to 1L) | Glass wine and spirit bottles (between 150ml and 3L)

NON ELIGIBLE CONTAINERS:

Cordial bottles | Large fruit or vegetable drinks (1L or larger)
Plain milk (plastic and cardboard) | Plain milk alternative drinks (soy, almond, other milk alternative drinks) | Large flavoured milk (1L or larger) | Other non-beverage containers

RECYCLE

Great care begins here



WHAT TO RECYCLE:

Cardboard boxes (packaging, cereal, shoe, pizza boxes)
Paper bags | Paper towels | Envelopes and junk mail
Glass bottles and jars | Plastic bottles and containers
Milk cartons | Juice boxes | Steel cans | Aluminium cans
Aerosol cans (deodorants or empty camping gas cartridges)
Tin foil | Foil trays | Egg cartons | Ice-cream tubs
