The Great Barrier Reef is one of the world's most iconic destinations for travellers. Yet there are still parts of the reef where visitors can feel like intrepid explorers, as if they were discovering places no one else has ever seen.

The Southern Great Barrier Reef offers visitors the chance to see large hard coral reefs firsthand and join colourful fish and big marine life like turtles and manta rays for a snorkel. At just over 4 hours drive from Brisbane, this unique region can easily be included as part of a larger itinerary and the snorkelling is within easy reach, right off the beach.



Mhy choose THE SOUTHERN GREAT BARRIER REEF?

Australia's Great Barrier Reef is 2,300 kilometres long and approximately 344,400 square kilometres in size – which is about 70 million football fields, or the size of Japan. So how do you choose what reef experience to recommend to visitors? Here are the 3 key reasons why your clients would choose the Southern Great Barrier Reef as their next holiday destination

REEF OFF LADY MUSGRAVE ISLAND

ACCESSIBILITY The Southern Great Barrier Reef starts only a short 4 hour drive or a 45 minute flight from Brisbane. You can reach the reef on a short day trip, or alternatively you can stay on an island of the Southern Great Barrier Reef, where the reef can be accessed straight from the beach on Lady Elliot, Heron, Wilson, Great Keppel and Pumpkin Islands.

GIANT MARINE LIFE Due to cooler waters in the Southern Great Barrier Reef there are slightly different types of coral to other parts of Great Barrier Reef, and an abundance of plankton which support GIANT marine life, like turtles and manta rays. Have you ever witnessed a manta ray with a wing span of 20 feet in length, or a loggerhead sea turtle that weighs 135 kilograms? You can when visiting the Southern Great Barrier Reef!

INTIMATE EXPERIENCES Tours and attractions in the Southern Great Barrier Reef are quality, generally small scale businesses, which means visitors will enjoy intimate group experiences, and feel like 'intrepid' explorers, receiving a very personal experience rather than being surrounded by mass amounts of other travellers.





Whether it be swimming, hatching, breaching, crawling or flying, the Southern Great Barrier Reef is always celebrating the wonders of nature.



See turtles laying their eggs and hatching on many of our beaches and islands. Ranger-guided tours are available at Mon Repos beach near Bargara (Nov-Mar), and many of our islands offer guided turtle encounters.



A once-a-year phenomenon when corals reproduce. The timing is linked to the lunar cycle and water temperatures. Divers say it looks like an underwater snowstorm.



Home to 80% of Australia's breeding population of bent-wing bats, see the emergent flight of thosands of these tiny creatures from a cave at dusk on a ranger-guided tour near Rockhampton.



Manta Ray can be seen all year round around the SGBR islands, however peak season is best for avid divers. Lady Elliot Island, Lady Musgrave Island and Heron Island are reknowned for these majestic creatures.



Our waters are abundant with seasonal migrating humpback whales. Whale watching tours depart from Bundaberg, Town of 1770 and Yeppoon, and you can spot whales from many of our islands and beaches when in season.

Bundaberg & Region

The closest access point to the Great Barrier Reef from Brisbane, Bundaberg is the town the turtles call home, where the reef touches the beach, where plates overflow with local produce and the rum is always world class.

HIGHLIGHTS: Bundaberg, Bargara & Mon Repos

DAY 1 - BUNDABERG & MON REPOS

Foodies, you have come to the right place! Bundaberg's rich red volcanic soil, abundant rivers and surrounding seas are the source of never ending seasonal produce. Whether you arrive via the sweeping streets of hinterland towns Childers and Gin Gin or fly into the heart of Bundaberg, you will be greeted by our rich patchwork of green farmlands and agricultural abundance.

Enjoy the cafe culture in our historical buildings and explore the exploding artisan food and drinks industry in the corner butcheries and bakeries, breweries and distilleries, and the farmer-led markets

From November to March, witness a miracle at the Mon Repos Turtle Encounter, a unique rangerguided turtle experience where you will see endangered Loggerhead mumma turtles nesting or baby turtles hatching. Book early!

DAY 2 - BUNDABERG

DAY 3 - BARGARA

Spend your morning on the beaches of our coastline. From the family friendly Kellys Beach with a manmade swimming lagoon and patrolled section, to the white sands of Elliott Heads, a kite-surfer's delight, to the miles-long expanses of Woodgate Beach in the south or the untouched sands of Moore Park Beach, there is something for everyone.

Spend some time in the village of Bargara, just 15 minutes from Bundaberg, before you wind your way home via the criss-cross grids and rows of seasonal produce and road-side market stalls.

LADY ELLIOT ISLAND (ex Bundaberg)

Visit the most southern point of the Great Barrier Reef at Lady Elliot Island. Renowned as 'Home of the Manta Ray', the island is regarded as one of the best diving and snorkelling locations on the Great Barrier Reef and is famous for its unspoilt coral reef and amazing array of spectacular marine life. Access to Lady Elliot Island is via a scenic flight departing Bundaberg Airport.

LADY MUSGRAVE ISLAND (ex Bundaberg)

Lady Musgrave Island is set on 3000 acres of living reef with a protected lagoon, making it a perfect spot for snorkelling and diving, with day trips departing from the Port of Bundaberg. Teeming with bird life above the water, and giant marine life below the water, you can swim with the turtles, dive alongside the manta rays, dance with the dolphins and witness the whales play. Gladstone & Agnes Water/ Town of 1770

Gladstone is full of unexpected surprises with contrasting features of industry, nature and the Great Barrier Reef, while Agnes Water and the Town of 1770 is the birthplace of Queensland and a relaxed hub of natural encounters.

HIGHLIGHTS: Gladstone & Agnes Water / Town of 1770

DAY 1 - GLADSTONE & AGNES WATER / TOWN OF 1770

Explore the wide green spaces of the Marina Parklands in Gladstone or wander the East Shores area with waterfront walks, stunning views from Auckland Point Hill and parks galore. Or find inspiration and relaxation in the Japanese Tea Gardens and lake front views of the Tondoon Botanic Gardens. Take a tour with a local guide and learn the stories of the area with Gladstone Region Tours

An easy 90 minute drive will take you to the relaxed seaside communities of Agnes Water and Town of 1770, with striking beaches looking over the deep blue waters of the Coral Sea. Relax on Queensland's most northern surf beaches or explore the menus of the quaint cafes of the town.

DAY 2 - AGNES WATER / TOWN OF 1770

This is one of the few places on the Australian mainland where you can watch the sun rise and set over water so make your way to the 1770 Headland and Lookout to enjoy the colourful skies of the waning day.

Start your morning with yoga on the beach or enjoy a lazy breakfast in a cafe of your choice.

Get your blood pumping as you kayak or go stand up paddle boarding. Then, explore the many walking trails that offer incredible views of the area. Make time for selfies on the whimsical circular Paperbark Trail or find the magnificent blue tiger butterflies migrating each autumn and winter in the Joseph Banks Conservation Park.







NORTH WEST ISLAND (ex Gladstone)

Situated 75km north-east of Gladstone and only accessible by boat, North West Island is ideal for tent camping and allows a maximum of 21 nights. Guests here will find composting toilets, fuel storage and a compressor bunker, but must bring everything else, including all food and drinking water. This camp area is nestled within a pisonia forest with access to a walking track. and offers easy access to snorkelling and diving or reef walking at low tide.

HERON & WILSON ISLANDS (ex Gladstone)

Heron Island is a true coral cay located right on the Great Barrier Reef, offering guided island and reef walks, semi-submersible cruises and private beach picnics are on offer. An amazing array of animals and bird life can be seen throughout the year. The island is also world famous for its fantastic scuba diving and snorkelling.

Jeppoon & Capricorn Coast

Taking its name from the Tropic of Capricorn, the Capricorn region is home to laid-back towns, quiet island life, pristine National Parks and secluded beaches. An enticing mix of country hospitality, modern city lifestyle and stunning coastal bays.

HIGHLIGHTS: Capricorn Caves, Koorana Crocodile Farm, Keppel Bay & Byfield Rainforest

DAY 1 - ROCKHAMPTON & CAPRICORN COAST

Start your Capricorn Region stay with a visit to the spectacular above ground limestone Capricorn Caves. Discover the amazing natural acoustics in the fully accessible Cathedral Chamber, travel back in time on the new fossil tour, or push your limits on an adventure caving experience.

After lunch, travel to Yeppoon on the Capricorn Coast. Explore some of the thirteen beaches along the scenic coastline from Yeppoon to Emu Park, or take an afternoon swim in the picturesque Yeppoon Lagoon followed by a walk along esplanade.

After dinner in a beach side café, unwind in the relaxed evenings of coastal Southern Great Barrier Reef.

DAY 2 - CAPRICORN COAST

A visit to Queensland isn't complete without a crocodile encounter, so kick off your day with a visit to Koorana Crocodile Farm. Get photographed with Australia's most ancient animal, and try the restaurant for lunch.

Enjoy 360-degree views of the Capricorn Coast and Keppel Bay at the Wreck Point scenic lookout

ADD ON AN ISLAND

located in Cooee Bay, or retrace Captain James Cook's footsteps at the Singing Ship and bring history to life at the ANZAC Memorial Walk and Emu Park Memorial Museum.

Complete your day with a sunset cruise on Keppel Bay with stunning views of unspoilt islands as you watch the sun set over the mountains with spectacular colours across wide, unbroken skies.

DAY 3 - BYFIELD

Drive just 25 minutes north of Yeppoon to the lush forests of Byfield and surrounding nature reserves. Explore the rolling sand dunes, beaches, swamps, rainforest-edged creeks and rugged mountains of Byfield Rainforest National Park, one of the largest unspoiled eco-systems on the east coast of Australia.

The small village of Byfield is a haven for craft and nature lovers, especially the world-class potter's gallery known as Nob Creek Pottery.

PUMPKIN ISLAND (ex Capricorn Coast)

One of Australia's best-kept island secrets is 14 kilometres off the coast from Yeppoon.

Expect to see dolphins, turtles and whales in season. Fish the rich waters, snorkel or experience the coral reefs from a glass bottom kayak or simply wander the secluded beaches. Perfect for safe swimming and snorkelling most of the year round. ACCOMMODATION - Pumpkin Island

GREAT KEPPEL ISLAND (ex Capricorn Coast)

From Yeppoon visit the Southern Great Barrier Reef's closest island to the mainland - Great Keppel Island. Step off the beach and snorkel in the clear blue water of the Southern Great Barrier Reef GKI offers excellent bush walking options leading you to one of it's 17 white sandy beaches. This island really is Queensland's best kept secret. Ferries depart Keppel Bay Marina daily (30min transfer).

ROCKHAMPTON & CAPRICORN COAST - 2 NIGHTS

The Capricorn Coast is an undiscovered paradise at the top of the Southern Great Barrier Reef. The coast is speckled with small townships, beautiful beaches, fantastic fishing and much more.

Explore some of the thirteen beaches along the scenic coastline from Yeppoon to Emu Park, or take a swim in the picturesque Yeppoon Lagoon followed by a walk along esplanade. The coastal townships are rich in cafes, restaurants and boutiques just waiting for you to discover them.

The the Wreck Point scenic lookout at Cooee Bay offers sweeping 360 degree views of the Capricorn Coast and Keppel Bay, or explore the unique tunes of the Singing Ship and exploring the history of the ANZAC Memorial Walk and Emu Park Memorial Museum.

The nearby village of Byfield is a haven for craft and nature lovers where you can enjoy picnics beside rainforest edged creeks.

No visit is complete without seeing Capricorn Caves and Koorana Crocodile farm - some of Queensland's oldest attractions offering both action-packed adventure and all-ages education.

Take in the spectacular sunsets on board an evening cruise through Keppel Bay.

Wander the historical streetscapes of Rockhampton, situated on the mighty Fitzroy River, and experience the thrill of watching professional bull riders in the Beef Capital at the Great Western Hotel in Rockhampton.

TOWN OF 1770/AGNES WATER - 2 NIGHTS Yeppoon to Agnes Water - 3hrs, 225kms

Agnes Water and the Town of 1770 sit snugly at the halfway point between Bundaberg and Gladstone, and it's here that Captain James Cook first set foot on the sparkling sands of the Sunshine State.

It's one of the Southern Great Barrier Reef's best kept secrets, offering some of the most sought after swimming, kayaking, kite surfing and bush walking anywhere in Queensland. Agnes Water also boasts the state's most northern surf beach, all within minutes from quaint cafes, surf shops and a range of beach front accommodation from backpackers to camping to resorts.

Don't miss the famous pink LARC. The day tour is the only way to explore Eurimbula National Parkland while their unique Goolimbil 'Black Cockatoo' Walkabout is an authentic indigenous hunting, gathering and tasting experience of a lifetime. Or immerse yourself in Australia's unique wildlife with a mainland tour.

You might also like to try your hand at stand up paddle boarding or an exciting kayak adventure too.

ATE BEACH

Bundaberg is rich with year-round fresh produce and iconic drinks. Enjoy a visit to the famous Bundaberg Rum Distillery or the Bundaberg Brewed Drinks Barrel, or meet the artisan producers on a guided cellar door tour.

Explore the red dirt roads to purchase direct from local farmers at the roadside stalls, or go behind the farm gates and meet the farmers themselves on a food tour. Choose from the ever-changing local cafe menus and creative dishes as chefs aim to showcase the best and freshest produce the region has-to offer. You are guaranteed to go home with a full tummy when you visit Australia's food bowl.

Bargara is a 13 kilometre drive through lush sugarcane fields from Bundaberg. It is a popular seaside area which harbours a peaceful and relaxed community ideal for family holidays. Roam deserted beaches or snorkel coral straight off the coast at Barolin Rocks.


