- Give plenty of room to road trains, in the NT they can be over 60 metres long.
- Caravans should travel at least 200m apart so other vehicles including road trains can safely pass.
- Respect private property. Once you leave the road you are on private property, please don't trespass, light fires, leave rubbish, camp, or cut fences.

CAMPING INFORMATION

There are numerous camping opportunities within the Red Centre. Venture through the national parks and reserves to find beautiful, designated campsites or visit a caravan/tourist park for included amenities.

If you plan to stay at a particular caravan park or campground, be sure to book well ahead of time to guarantee a site, especially during peak periods like school holidays and long weekends.

In order to protect our environment, we urge people to please camp only in the designated tourist/caravan parks and/or structured campsites.
