

PERMITS

Aboriginal Land Permits are legally required when travelling through some areas throughout Central Australia. In some cases, multiple permits are required when travelling one road that passes through more than one council region.

Mereenie Loop

The Mereenie Loop is the unsealed section of the Red Centre Way that connects Larapinta Drive / Namatjira Drive in the West MacDonnell Ranges, to Luritja Drive in Kings Canyon. Permits are per vehicle, and are available in person (not online) from multiple locations including; Alice Springs Visitor Information Centre, Central Land Council office, Hermannsburg Store, Glen Helen, Standley Chasm, Discovery Parks Kings Canyon and Kings Creek Station. Camping along the Mereenie Loop is not permitted. Permits are valid for 3 (three) days from date of purchase.

Anyone passing through an Aboriginal community via a public road can visit public areas such as the store, art centre or local gov office without a permit. A transit permit is required if the community is accessed via a non-public road.

Tjukururu Road (Great Central Road)

- Between Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park boundary and the WA border
- Allows access to Tjunti (Lasseters Cave)
- Camping is only allowed at Kaltukatjara (Docker River) campground.

Gary Junction Road (NT Section)

- Between Papunya and WA border

Sandy Blight Junction Road (NT Section)

- Between Kintore and Docker River
- Also see Ngaanyantjarra Permit

Glen Helen - Papunya Road

- Between Namatjira Drive and Papunya
- Transit Permit allows day access to Ikuntji

Tjukururu Road (Great Central Road)

- Between Laverton and the NT border
- 3 days or less, limited to transit and refuelling

Gary Junction Road (WA Section)

- Between Gary Junction and WA border
- Kintore Rd/Kiwirrkurra Rd

Giles Mulga Park Road (WA Section)

- Limited to transit and refuel, and use of Jameson, Blackstone and Wingellina Stores

Sandy Blight Junction Road (WA Section)

- Also see CLC Permit

Surveyor Generals Corner

- Weekdays only, no weekends or public holidays
- \$100 per vehicle
