

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the event?

The event is Sunday 10 April from 10am – 2pm.

Do I need to book to attend the event? No, you will not need to book tickets to attend the event.

Do I need to be vaccinated or QR code in to gain access to the site?

As per the State Government mandate, all persons over 18 entering the event site will be required to be fully vaccinated and provide evidence of this via the Vic Services QR code app to gain entry to the event. This is because this event falls under the entertainment guidelines and is a private venue that is enclosed.

What is the 2022 theme for the event?

The theme for 2021 is 'Garden' come along dressed for a day in the Garden or even your favorite floral, bug or anything else Garden theme for a chance to win some prizes!

How much will the event and activities cost?

It is free to attend our Party in the Park event; however, you should bring some money if you wish to purchase food or items from market vendors at the event. Will there be food and drinks available? There will be a community BBQ, Fish and Chips, Toasted sandwiches and coffee stalls available at the event. Feel free to also bring along a picnic lunch.

Can I bring my pet to the event?

No. Animals are not permitted at the event. Service animals are welcome.

Is the event smoke and alcohol free?

Yes. Smoking and alcohol are not permitted at the event or on the grounds of Cruden Farm.

What other facilities are on site?

Toilets – There are toilet facilities, including accessible toilets onsite.

Drinking water - The will be drinking fountains at the event. Don't forget to bring your reusable bottle to refill!

Baby care – There will be a parent facilities marquee, which will be equipped with a baby change table and feeding chairs.

What if the weather is inclement?

In some conditions, it may be necessary for aspects of these events to be modified. In extreme conditions, where it is deemed unsafe to continue, programming may be delayed or cancelled. You can keep up to date by following the Frankston Events Facebook page.

Where will I be able to Park?

There will be car parking available during the event. Please enter via Cranhaven Road or McClelland Drive and follow the traffic controller's directions.

Will there be any accessible parking?
There are a limited number of designated accessible car parking spaces available,

please inform the traffic controllers upon entry and they will direct you.

Can I take public transport to the event? Yes, we encourage you to take public transport where possible. Head to www.ptv.vic.gov.au to plan your journey. Will there be security at this event?

Yes, Security will be monitoring the event and monitoring compliance with our COVID Safe measures.

What COVID Safe measures will be present at this event?

In-line with our COVID Safe Plan for the event all patrons must adhere to the below terms and conditions:

- As per the State Government mandate, all persons entering the event site will be required to be in line with the current COVID-19 vaccine to be permitted to enter the event site; unless they have a valid exemption.
- All patrons must scan the QR code on arrival upon entering the event site to undertake vaccination checks for all persons over the age of 18. This is a requirement as our event is operating under the entertainment guidelines and is a private venue that is enclosed.
