

## Renmark Paringa Council RV Parks & Campsites Information Sheet

Renmark Paring Council recognises that RV Parks and Campsites are important tourism infrastructure and economic drivers in our district that cater for visitors and locals alike. The following information and requirements are relevant to camping in the Council's designated areas. In some cases, non-compliance with these requirements may result in contravention of the law and penalties may apply.

- Generators are permitted to be used at our sites, though need to be used in a considerate manner with minimal disruption to other campers. Generators can be used between 8am – 8pm only.
- Toilets are provided at each of our RV Parks & Campsites. Tent toilets are not permitted within
  any of our sites. Toilet waste or grey water is to ONLY be disposed of at the Dump Point in the
  carpark of the Renmark Swimming Centre, Murtho Street, Renmark NEVER on the ground,
  near the river or in bushland.
- Water onsite is not suitable for drinking. Potable water / water to refill tanks can be accessed in the carpark of the Renmark Swimming Centre, Murtho Street, Renmark.
- Personal comfort fires are permitted within the fireplaces / fire rings provided. It is illegal to take
  wood from a roadside or reserve for campfire use. Firewood needs to be brought with campers
  or purchased from a firewood supplier. Ensure that all fires are extinguished (with water, not
  sand as it retains heat which can cause severe burns) whenever you leave your campsite
  unattended.
- FIRE DANGER SEASON The Fire Danger Season generally runs from November through to April, although these dates may change due to seasonal conditions. The exact dates are published prior to the Fire Danger Season. During the Fire Danger Season restrictions are placed on lighting fires to reduce the chances of large fires starting. These restrictions are escalated when a Total Fire Ban Day is declared. - Leave no trace of your visit take all your rubbish with you and leave all facilities clean and tidy for the next user. Fines may apply for non-compliance.
- Be respectful of other people, their campsites, property and privacy be aware of your noise levels (especially in the early morning and late evening) and ensure that you walk around other campsites.



- Mosquitos are commonly found around the river, associated waterways and floodplain areas.
   Campers should take precautions to avoid mosquito bites by wearing long, light coloured clothing and using a repellent.
- Water safety is vital near or in the Murray River. Anyone visiting or using the river needs to
  understand and be aware of the dangers associated with the depth, currents, access and flows
  of the waterway. It is strongly recommended that children wear a life jacket at all times near and
  around water and are always supervised.
- Dogs are welcome at our RV Parks & Campsites, though must be on leash at all times. Please pick up and dispose of all droppings appropriately.
- Motorbike riding is only permitted on designated roads and tracks.
- It is strongly recommended that you do not camp directly under large gum trees, especially river
  red gum and black box gum species. These trees are susceptible to dropping large branches at
  any time, especially during extended dry periods. These limbs can be extremely large and may
  endanger your safety or life should they fall on your campsite.
- Any valuables left unattended at your campsite are at your own risk. The Council does not accept responsibility for loss or damage.

## **Park Closures**

Renmark Paringa Council retains the right to close our RV Parks and Campsites for management purposes including, but not limited to, due to wet weather, fire danger restrictions (such as catastrophic fire danger days) or other fire / emergency management related activities. These closures may occur with limited notice.

In the event that a RV Parks and Campsite is closed or restricted, a full refund will be issued for booking for affected nights. It is advised that you check weather conditions prior to arrival particularly during the Fire Danger Season and any enquiries can be directed to the Renmark Paringa Visitor Information Centre or Renmark Paringa Council.
