Southern 80 Ski Race

Southern 80 is the world's largest ski race. An elite line-up of International and Australian skiers, vying for the prestigious superclass title, traversing 80kms of bends and straights of the mighty Murray River. The action includes the Breakfast with the stars and great racing such as the Baker's Blitz, the Presidents Dash and the Southern 80 ski race. Friday sees the Breakfast with the stars and the Hall of Fame Night. Saturday morning check out the Harry O's Boat Display outside the American Hotel from 8am to 12 noon. Saturday's action takes place between Moama's Five Mile Reserve and the Victoria Park Finish Line Precinct. Saturday's highlights include the Southern 80 Boat Parade at around 1.30pm and the Top 40 Shootout at around 2.30pm (including the presidents dash and bakers blitz) with the top 40 boats vying for pole position on Sunday. Sunday's action takes place between Torrumbarry Weir and the Victoria Park Finish Line Precinct. Sunday's highlights include the top boats fighting it out to win the Southern 80. The best place to be part of all the action is the Victoria Park Finish Line – one day passes are \$25 with weekend passes \$35 – tickets can be secured at www.southern80.com.au Parking in the vicinity of the finish line area is limited, so courtesy buses will operate between the High Street Car Park and Victoria Park.
