Entries in this category must be made from either full or half 44 gallon drums. They can be decorated or refashioned, however they **MUST** still be functional as a fire drum.

FIRE DRUM EXHIBITOR

RULES & CONDITIONS

CREATE

- Create or purchase a safe, functional fire drum
- Must be safe and stable
- Must not have any sharp edges or bits that stick out
- No accelerants
- Pre-burn to ensure there are no fumes on the night
- Clean any flammable or fume producing material

DELIVER

- Deliver and set up at the Charleville Showgrounds, between 9am and 12pm Saturday 1 July 2023
- See stewards for details and to get your location
- Bring drums empty. We will supply wood.
- All wood to be stored safely at drum site to reduce tripping hazards
- Ensure all drums are stable and secure

ENTER

- Pick a category
- Fill in the entry form on drop your entry forms into the Murweh Shire Council office or email them to tourism@murweh.qld.gov.au
- Late entries will not be accepted
- Entries close at 5pm 27th June 2023

ATTEND

- Attend and supervise your drum
- Judging begins at 4pm
- The Rural Fire Brigade will light the drums after judging
- Unsafe or unsupervised drums will not be lit
- The exhibitor remains responsible for the safety of their drum during the event
- Advise steward if you are leaving before 9pm

COLLECT

- Remove drums on Sunday 2nd July
- Children to be in the immediate supervision of an adult at all times
- Clean up any rubbish, coals or embers around your drum area
- Any remaining embers in drums to be disposed on in the main bonfire area
- DO NOT leave the grounds with embers in your drum
