



WESTBURY SILHOUETTE TRAIL

A level, easy walk around the historic village of Westbury that follows a series of metal sculptures depicting historical characters from the village.

The walk passes many historical buildings that were features of the 1800s garrison established in what was nearly the capital city of Tasmania. The trail is suitable for all abilities.



Time: 1 hour return

Distance: 3.5 km return



Westbury is located between Deloraine and Launceston on the B54 Meander Valley Rd. The walk starts adjacent to the Meander Valley Council offices at 26 Lyall St, Westbury where maps of the trail are available.

There are public toilets, shops and cafes along the trail. BBQs and picnic facilities can be found on the town common.



Grade 1: No bushwalking experience required. Flat even surface with no steps or steep sections. Suitable for wheelchair users who have someone to assist them.



Supervise children as the trail follows public roads and footpaths.

Stroll around the heart of Westbury and encounter 8 exquisite metal artworks, each depicting a treasured character of the community.

The characters celebrated in the Westbury Silhouette Trail are examples of the many inspirational lives that have built this community. Quirky, skillful, stylish, bold and compassionate - they reveal the strands of humanity that bind communities and from which all good things grow.

Westbury's story is deeply embedded in British colonialism and Irish culture; formed by the dedication of early Irish clergy and the toil of convict, soldier and free settler alike.
