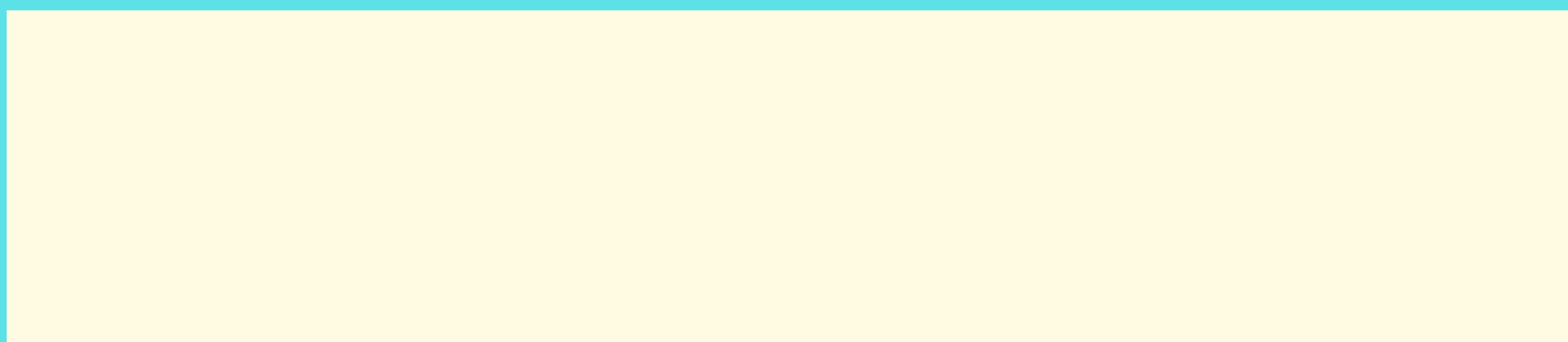




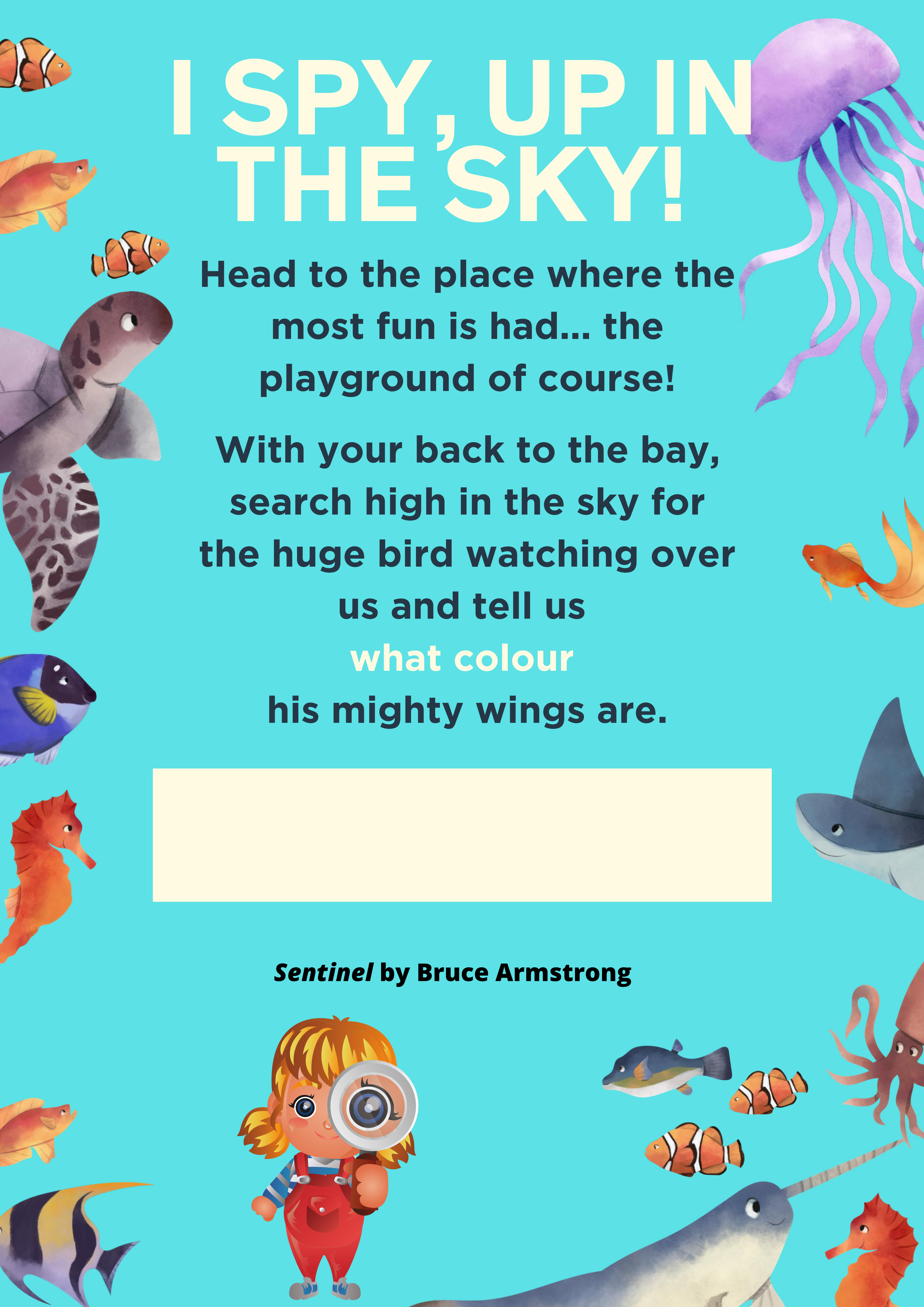
# I SPY, UP IN THE SKY!

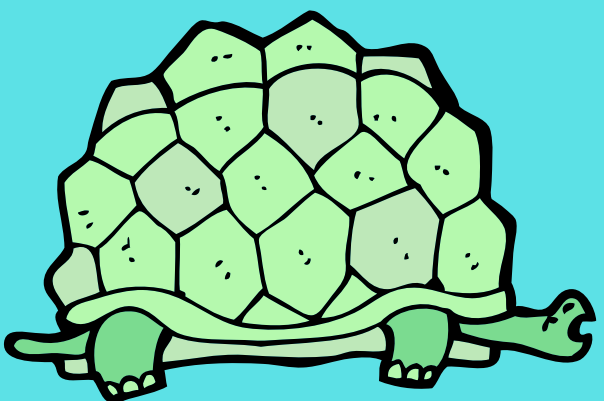
# DID YOU KNOW?



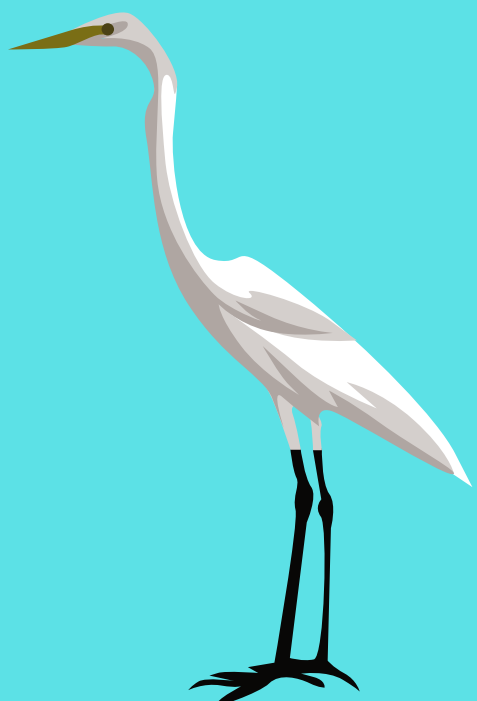
**Australia's coastline stretches almost 50,000 kilometres and has over 10,000 beaches. That's more than any other country in the world!**
