1. SHAUN DEVENNEY @artbyshaun_dev
 43B Davey St

Scottish artist creating realism based artworks addressing societal issues, exploring how we operate in an ever changing world, using textures, satire, and humour.



2. JACK ROWLAND @jackrowlandart
 101 Young St

Reimagines landscape through hyper-saturated colour, transforming natural imagery into surreal, heightened perceptual environments.



3. BUFF DISS @buffdis
 43 Playne St

Reworks urban surfaces with bold, textured murals that combine gritty street aesthetics with contemporary mural practice.



4. ARINA APOSTOLOVA @apostolovart
 Rear 80–82 Young St (in Gallery lane)

Mural artist creating composite realism with symbolic, illustrative elements, combining aesthetics with meaningful narratives across public spaces and community engagement.



5. CREATURE CREATURE @creaturecreaturestudios
 31 Beach St

Creates playful murals and installations combining illustration, pattern and sculptural elements into layered, character-driven visual worlds.



6. FATHER MARKER @father.marker
 15 Beach St

Develops site-responsive murals and street art informed by location, symbolism and organic form, drawing on Australian flora, fauna, mythology and storytelling within urban environments.



7. SAM ABSURD @samabsurd
 Olsen St (loading dock)

Disrupts urban environments with surreal figures, sharp line work and subversive imagery driven by humour and concept.



8. JUZPOP @juzpop
 Wells Ln

Creates surreal, colour-rich paintings exploring inner worlds. Female figures intertwine with natural elements in layered, dreamlike compositions that respond to and flow with each wall.




9. MICK RUSSELL @mickrussell_

Melbourne-based muralist painting bold lettering and iconography that bridges graffiti tradition and contemporary public art.




MANDA LANE @mandalaneart

Botanical muralist layering hand-drawn plants and patterns into urban settings, exploring ecology, resilience and the built environment.




NERYL WALKER @nerylwalker
