SPRING BLUFF DRIVE DIRECTIONS

- 1 Starting at the Lake Apex Information Centre head west 20km towards Toowoomba
- 2 Right turn to Murphys Creek via Postman's Ridge Road (East)
- 3 Right turn into Murphys Creek Road
- 4 Continue on Murphys Creek Road
- 5 Turn left into McCormack Dr for access to Spring Bluff Railway Station
- 6 Turn right onto the New England Highway, proceed to Collingwood Road via Highfields, Cabarlah & Geham
- 7 Turn right into Collingwood Road and continue onto Fifeen Mile Road
- 8 Turn left into Postman's Ridge Road (East)
- 9 Left turn into the Warrego Highway returning to Gatton via Grantham
