

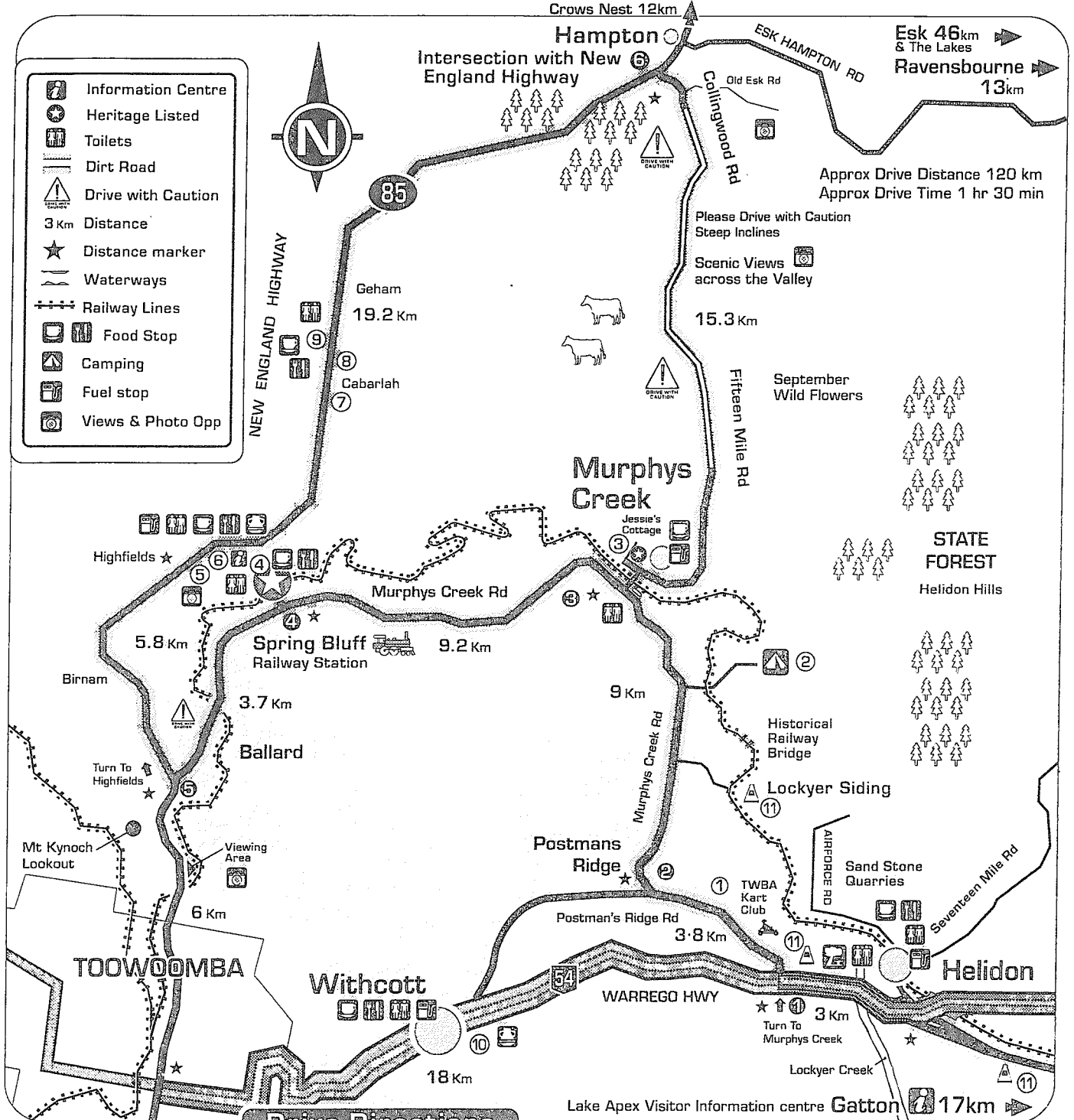

Drive Directions

- Starting at the Gatton Lake Apex Information centre, head west 20km towards Toowoomba, then take the
- right turn to Murphys Creek via Postmans Ridge Road
 - right turn into Murphys Creek Road.
 - At Murphys Creek Village continue on Murphys Creek Road to
 - Spring Bluff Heritage Listed Railway Station.
 - Turn right onto the New England Highway, proceed to Collingwood Road via Highfields, Cabarlah & Geham.
 - Turn right into Collingwood Road and continue on to
 - Murphys Creek, turn left to cross the railway line, Turn left again into Murphys Creek Road and
 - turn left into Postman's Ridge Road.
 - Turn left onto the Warrego Highway, returning to Gatton via Grantham.
