SUGAR CANE AND SEASIDE SUNSETS

Hit the ground running in Mackay Isaac by embarking on a true farm-to-plate experience at **Oh Deere Farm Stay**. This interactive tour of a working sugar cane farm will give you a taste of life on the land and a newfound appreciation of the hard work it takes to put food on our tables.

Travel onwards to Cape Hillsborough National Park for your beachside accommodation. For dinner, head to the Mount Jukes Family Farm for some authentic Italian pizzas.

DAY FOUR


CITY EXPLORERS

Return to Mackay, where you can speed things up or slow things down! Lounge by the pool at the Bluewater Lagoon, stroll through the Mackay Regional Botanic Gardens, check out the colourful Fifth Lane street art murals, and enjoy lunch at one of the many cafés and restaurants in the city heart. Speed things up with a jet boat ride on Purple Thunder for adrenaline-pumping drifts and turns, or visit Wake House Australia for wakeboarding and lakeside brews.

In the afternoon, travel south to experience a sugar cane mill in miniature at the award-winning **Sarina Sugar Shed**. Enjoy a guided tour, learn about the harvesting process, and taste some sweet treats and brews before returning to Mackay.

DAY SIX

STEP BACK INTO GOLD RUSH HISTORY

Don't miss a hearty pub lunch at the historic **Nebo Hotel** and a visit to the **Nebo Museum**. If time allows, venture north to visit the ghost town of **Mount Britton**, an abandoned pioneer gold mining town of the 1880s, surrounded by dramatic mountain ranges.

Drive further inland to **Clermont**, admiring the changing landscapes and striking peaks of the Peak Range National Park along the way.

DAY SEVEN

COUNTRY ROAD TRIPS AND BEYOND

It's time to explore – visit the **Clermont Museum** to check out artefacts and machinery from the past, visit **Theresa Creek Dam** to drop in a line or enjoy some onwater sports, and explore the beautiful town and local shopping.

Finish your trip with a once-in-a-lifetime helicopter experience with **Bush Heli-Services**. Get a birds-eye view over nearby peaks including the incredible **Lords Table Mountain**, explore nearby mines and townships from the air, and the beautiful Theresa Creek Dam.

From here, you can return to Mackay via Peak Range Highway, explore off the beaten tracks through Dysart and Middlemount to get up close with Lords Table Mountain, or continue your journey along the Great Inland Way.
