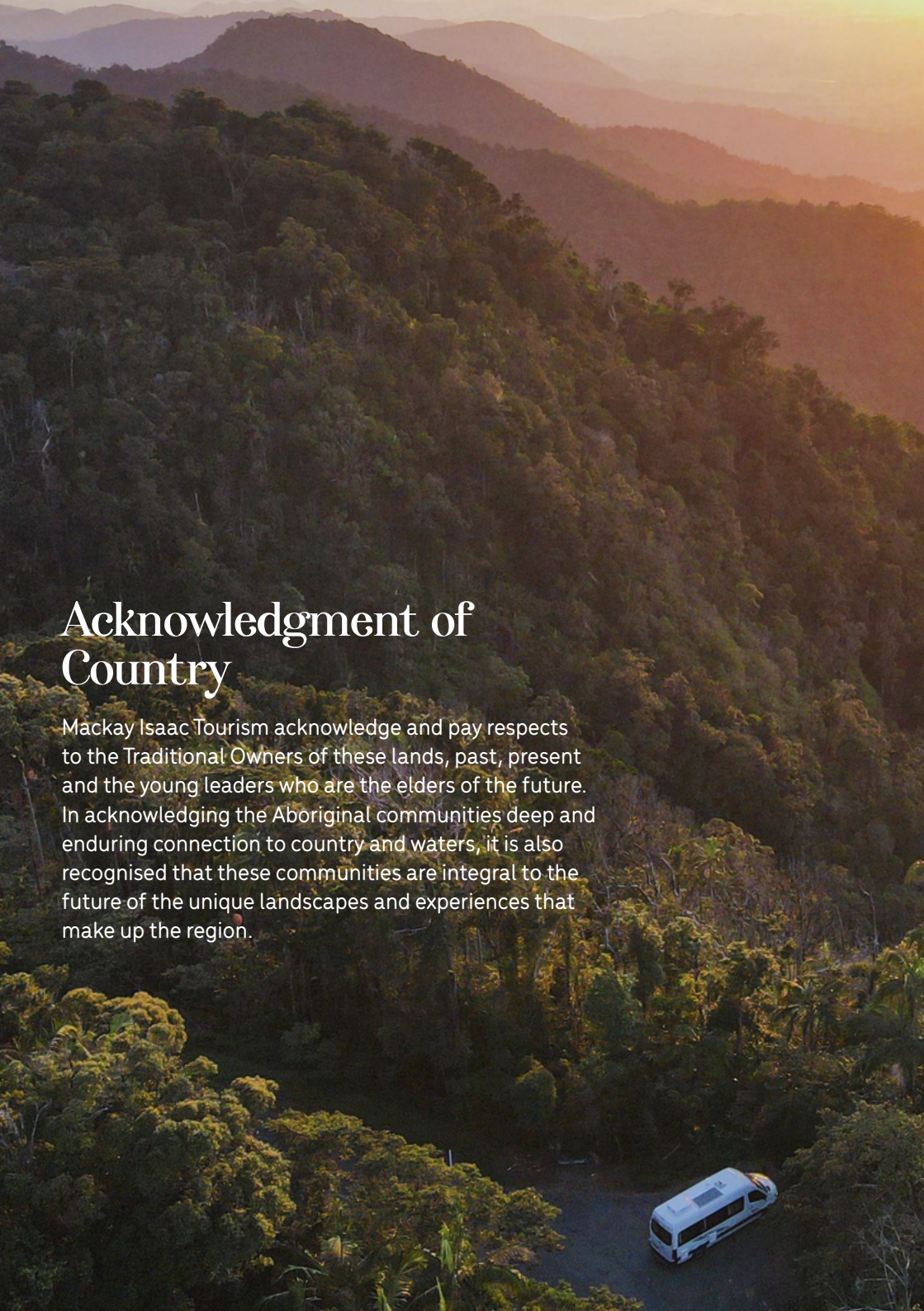

GETTING AROUND

By Taxi - Call 131 008 or taxi ranks located in the city center, shopping centers & airports.

By Bus - Kinetic operate a public bus schedule across Mackay, Sarina and the Pioneer Valley, as well as long distance services through the Isaac Region.

By Car - Hire a car from one of our many car rental companies.

Private transfers - Flexible transport options available, such as Off Camber Transfers and Mackay Adventure Tours and Transfers.

GETTING HERE

By Air - Mackay Airport is serviced by Qantas, Jetstar and Virgin Australia. Moranbah Airport is serviced by Alliance Airlines, Qantas Airways and National Jet Express. Short and long-term parking is available at both airports.

By Rail - Queensland Rail travels to and from Mackay, with the train station located in Paget, 5km south of the city center.

By Road - Major coach operators include Mackay in their scheduled services from destinations throughout Queensland.

By Sea - Port of Mackay is in development to accommodate Cruise Ships. Mackay Marina can accommodate vessels ranging from 10m up to 55m. It is a Port of Entry to Australia with Customs and Border Protection on site.

Located just 5km from the Mackay CBD, Mackay Airport is the gateway to the Mackay Isaac region with over 110 flights arriving and departing each week, operated by Qantas, Jetstar and Virgin Australia. 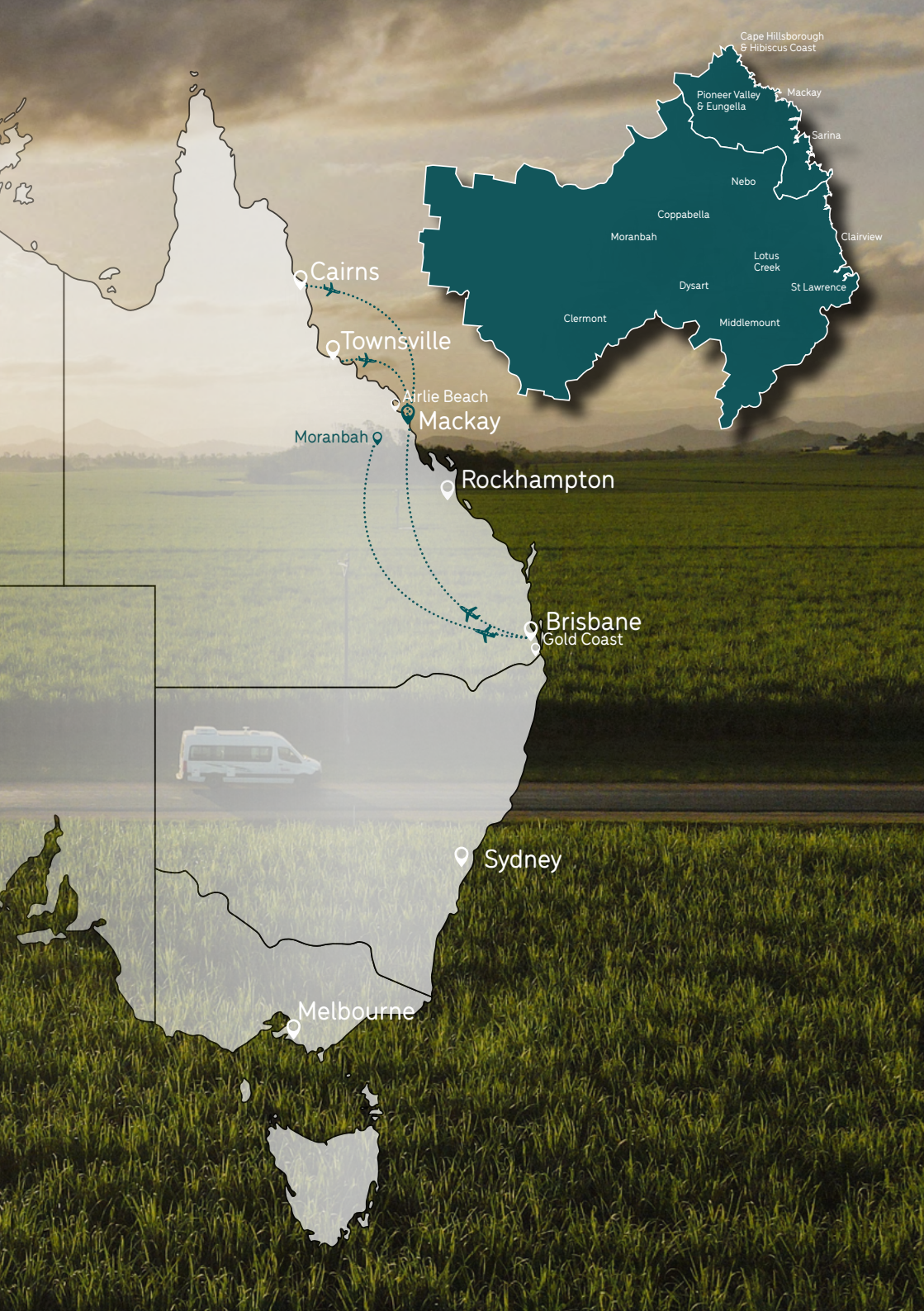

2. Chase waterfalls, hike and swim at Finch Hatton Gorge.



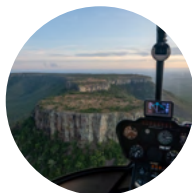
3. Spot platypus at Broken River in Eungella National Park.

Mackay City & Surrounds

Nestled on the banks of one of Australia's rare blue water rivers, Mackay can be as exciting, or as peaceful, as you desire.

A trip to Mackay promises experiences that make you feel like you're chartering your own adventure. Whether it be a self guided heritage trail, exploring local produce or visiting the Wake House (yes, we have our very own wakeboarding park!).

Begin exploring the city at Bluewater Quay and marvel at public art and impressive art deco architecture. Visit Artspace or see a show at the Mackay Entertainment & Convention Centre. Follow the banks of the Pioneer River along the Bluewater Trail before taking a refreshing swim at Bluewater Lagoon. The trail continues through natural river wetlands along a raised boardwalk all

the way to the Mackay Regional Botanic Gardens.

Just 8km's from the city heart, delight in waterfront views at Mackay's modern marina. View luxury yachts gently bobbing on the tranquil harbour, as you savour the casual cuisine along the palm-lined promenade.

The award-winning Sarina Sugar Shed is located in the township of Sarina (approximately 36km's south of Mackay) offering a miniature sugar mill and distillery experience.



Valleys & Mountains

Eungella, pronounced 'Yung-ga-lah' translates to Land of the Clouds and is Australia's longest stretch of sub-tropical rainforest.

A wonderland of waterfalls, lush flora and volcanic boulder formations contrast against a tapestry of sugar cane fields as you head through the Pioneer Valley into Eungella National Park. Getting to Eungella National Park is an adventure in itself!

The Pioneer Valley is the gateway to Eungella and encompasses many rural townships and sights to see with a long history of sugar farming and mills to spot along the way.

Within the Pioneer Valley, walk the well-formed tracks to the Araluen Cascades or Wheel of Fire waterfalls at Finch Hatton Gorge and take a dip in freshwater swimming

holes or try your hand at mountain biking at the Finch Hatton Mountain Bike Trails. Stop in at a local country pub or locally stocked cafes.

Once up in Eungella, walk the banks of Broken River, one of the best places to see platypus in their natural environment and take a short walk to see the view from Sky Window.

Other points of interest include: Fishing at Kinchant, Teemurra or Eungella Dam, visiting the historical Melba House in Marian or browsing interesting artifacts at Mirani Museum.



Unspoilt Coastal Gems

With a backdrop of clear blue skies and the sparkling Coral Sea, The Mackay Isaac Region is home to many pristine beaches and islands that are ready to be explored and discovered.

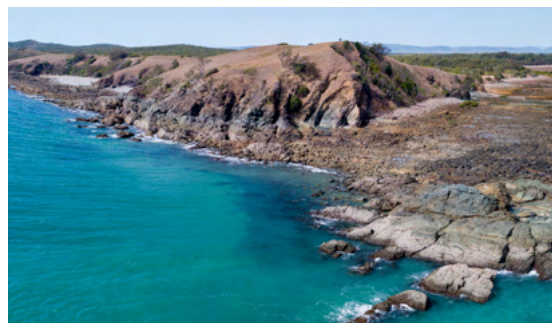
The South Cumberland Islands National Park encompasses nine islands with protected coves, sheltered long sandy beaches, and deep gullies hiding remnants of dry rainforest.

Ringed by fringing reefs, many of the islands are important rookeries for flatback and green turtles. Take a trip with Endless Days or charter your own boat to explore the amazing coral sea.

Spread along the coast of the Mackay Isaac Region are over 30 beaches just waiting to be explored.

A star attraction is the rugged natural paradise of Cape Hillsborough National Park - Where wallabies arrive on the beach every morning to find washed up seed pods to eat. Book this magical experience with Mackay Adventure Tours or spend the night at Cape Hillsborough Nature Tourist Park to experience this phenomenon.

South of Mackay is the Isaac Region, Clairview, offers a golden beach famous for crabbing and a protected dugong sanctuary. Further south you will find St Lawrence, one of the oldest towns on the coast of Queensland and home to the St Lawrence Wetlands.



The Convenient Outback

Head inland on the Peak Downs Highway to discover a diverse rugged playground, where the golden red soil of the outback contrasts with the 'black gold' extracted from the mineral-rich Isaac Plains coal mines.

For a scenic drive, travel along the Peak Downs Highway for panoramic views of Peak Range National Park consisting of four sections: Wolfgang Peak, Eastern Peak, Lord's Table Mountain and Gemini Mountains. These spectacular mountains are best viewed by helicopter with Bush Helli-Services.

Nebo has a diverse array of historical sites in the region including the Mount Britton Gold Mining site, and the intrepid traveller can find the site where Leichardt camped as he explored the region in 1845. Nebo's heritage

listed hotel still retains the great character and is well worth a visit just to soak up some history and enjoy a cool ale.

The town of Clermont is one of the most historic towns in northern Australia, having a colourful past, rich in drama and laced with tragedy. It was the first inland settlement in the tropics, making it a frontier town in the truest sense of the word. Declared a goldfield in 1862, Clermont is the most accessible field in Queensland, attracting keen prospectors from all around Australia (and the world) to try their luck fossicking for gold. The Isaac region has an array of camping, caravanning and RV locations for every traveller.

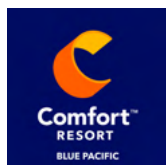
