

By Air - Mackay Airport is serviced by Bonza, Jetstar, Qantas and Virgin Australia. Moranbah Airport is serviced by Qantas and Alliance Airlines. Short and



Mackay City And Surrounds

Nestled on the banks of one of Australia's rare blue water rivers, Mackay can be as exciting, or as peaceful, as you desire.

A trip to Mackay promises experiences that make you feel like you're chartering your own adventure. Whether it be a self guided heritage trail, exploring local produce or visiting the Wakehouse (yes, we have our very own wakeboarding park!)

Begin exploring the city at Bluewater Quay and marvel at public art and impressive art deco architecture. Visit Artspace, see a show at the Mackay Entertainment & Convention Centre.

Follow the banks of the Pioneer River along the Bluewater Trail before taking a refreshing swim at Bluewater Lagoon. The trail continues through natural river wetlands along a raised boardwalk all the way to the Mackay Regional Botanic Gardens.


Delight in waterfront views at Mackay's modern marina. View luxury yachts gently bobbing on the tranquil harbour, as you savour the casual cuisine along the palm-lined promenade.

The award-winning Sarina Sugar Shed is also located in the township of Sarina (approximately 36 kilometres south of Mackay) offering a miniature sugar mill and distillery experience.













Valleys & Mountains in the Land of Clouds

DID YOU KNOW? Eungella is pronounced 'Yung-galah' and translates to Land of the Clouds. Eungella National Park is Australia's longest stretch of subtropical rainforest.

A wonderland of waterfalls, lush flora and volcanic boulder formations contrast against a tapestry of sugar cane fields as you head through the Pioneer Valley into Eungella National Park.

And getting to Eungella National Park is an adventure in itself!

The Pioneer Valley is the gateway to Eungella and encompasses many rural townships and sights to see with a long history of sugar farming and mills to spot along the way.

Within the Pioneer Valley, walk the well-formed tracks to the Araluen Cascades or Wheel of Fire waterfalls at Finch Hatton Gorge and take a refreshing dip in the freshwater swimming holes. Stop in a local country pub or experience fine dining bush tucker at The Flackyard.

Once up in Eungella, walk the banks of Broken River, one of the best places to see platypus in their natural environment and take a short walk to see the view from Sky Window.

Other points of interest includes: Fishing at Kinchant, Teemburra or Eungella Dam, visiting the historical Melba House in Marian or browsing interesting artifacts at Mirani Museum.

Discover Unspoilt Coastal Gems

With a backdrop of clear blue skies and the sparkling Coral Sea, The Mackay Isaac Region is home to many pristine beaches and islands that are ready to be explored and discovered.

The South Cumberland Islands National Park encompasses nine islands with protected coves, sheltered long sandy beaches, and deep gullies hiding remnants of dry rainforest

Ringed by fringing reefs, many of the islands are important rookeries for flatback and green turtles. Take a trip on Wildcat or charter your own boat to explore the amazing coral sea.

Spread along the coast of the Mackay Isaac Region are over 30 beaches just waiting to be explored.

A star attraction is the rugged natural paradise of Cape Hillsborough National Park - Where wallabies arrive on the beach every morning to find washed up seed pads to eat. Book this magical experience with Mackay Adventure Tours or spend the night at Cape Hillsborough Nature Tourist Park to experience this phenomenon.

South of Mackay in the Isaac Region, Clairview offers a golden beach famous for crabbing and a protected dugong sanctuary. Further south you will find St Lawrence, one of the oldest towns on the coast of Queensland and home to the St Lawrence Wetlands.













Explore Isaac's Convenient Outback

Head inland on the Peak Downs Highway to discover a diverse rugged playground, where the golden red soil of the outback contrasts with the 'black gold' extracted from the mineral-rich Isaac Plains coal mines.

For a scenic drive, travel along the Peak Downs
Highway for panoramic views of Peak Range
National Park consisting of four sections; Wolfang
Peak, Eastern Peak, Lord's Table Mountain and
Gemini Mountains. These spectacular mountains are
best viewed by helicopter or for the adventurous, by
hiking!

Nebo has a diverse array of historical sites in the region including the Mount Britton Gold Mining site, and the intrepid traveller can find the site where Leichardt camped as he explored the region in 1845. Nebo's heritage listed hotel still retains the great character and is well worth a visit just to soak up some history and enjoy a cool ale.

The town of Clermont is one of the most historic towns in northern Australia, having a colourful past, rich in drama and laced with tragedy. It was the first inland settlement in the tropics, making it a frontier town in the truest sense of the word. Declared a goldfield in 1862 and as the most accessible field in Queensland, Clermont attracts keen prospectors from all around Australia (and the world!) to try their luck fossicking for gold

The Isaac region is has an array of camping, caravanning and RV locations for every traveller.

Get Hooked on Fishing

It has never been easier to catch a legendary metre-plus barramundi!

The Mackay Isaac Region is well known nationally and internationally, as one of the best fishing locations in Australia. Within 45 minutes you can be fishing at a tropical reef, rainforest stream, blue water river, a sandy estuary or an inland dam. With the highest fishing participation rate in the state, a huge variety of species and world class fishing and boating facilities Mackay Isaac offers the perfect destination for your next fishing adventure.

One of the greatest things about the region is the on-water options – there is always somewhere to fish, no matter the wind or tide. The locals often talk about "from reef to rainforest" and that pretty much sums up the fishing too. Not every day has great tides and five knot winds, but with the reef, Shipping Channel, islands, creeks, dams or rainforest streams to choose from, somewhere is always accessible.

If you're looking for a guided fishing trip to really sink your teeth into recreational fishing, then a local charter might be for you. We have a range of experienced charter operators in our region waiting to get you hooked up to a range of trophy species. From long-range offshore trips to the Great Barrier Reef, to customised inshore trips focusing on your bucket list, through to freshwater flyfishing - there is a trip for every taste and style of fishing.



Inshore Fishing

From large creek systems like St Lawrence Wetlands in the south to the beautiful bluewater Pioneer River in the centre of town and north to the Mackay Net Free Zone at Cape Hillsborough, the Mackay Isaac region is blessed with an abundance of pristine fisheries.

Most of the the region's estuary systems are wild ecosystems, with mangrove-lined banks, scattered rocks and sand bars. In the majority, most systems are fairly shallow, especially over larger tidal cycles, and only the larger systems can be easily accessed from the mouth at dead low tide. This means that fish, like barra, mangrove jack and fingermark, can be actively targeted over the low parts of the tide when they congregate in deep holes, bends and along banks where fallen timber is submerged.

Offshore Fishing

There are plenty of options available offshore Mackay Isaac to stretch your arms and heat up your drags. Inshore coastal islands, reefs and shoals abound and are easily accessed and navigated with small vessels. These small islands and reefs hold fish, especially pelagics like trevally, mackerel and queenfish. Shallow water reef species like grass sweetlip and coral trout are also regular catches.


Further offshore, more seaworthy vessels can access the Sir James Smith Group of islands (from Seaforth), the Cumberland Islands (off Mackay) and the Beverley Group (off Sarina). Water depths around these islands vary, but are generally 30-40m, making them ideal for larger reef species and trophy pelagics like big spanish mackerel and giant trevally.

Dams & Freshwater Fishing

When it comes to freshwater fishing, the Mackay Isaac region has world-class fishing impoundments which can be fished all year round, plus the pristine Pioneer River and Cattle Creek which offer stunning scenery and sensational fishing.

Head west from Mackay to find Kinchant,
Teemburra and Eungella Dams which are known as
some of the best fishing spots in the world for world
record barramundi and sooty grunter. Heading
further west into the Isaac's you will find the
beautiful Theresa Creek Dam.






