* Auditor travel expenses are in addition to certification fees. Such Travel Costs will be reimbursed upon submission of relevant invoices. To ensure travel expenses are kept at a minimum, Certification Services are conducted on a regional schedule in order to streamline Benchmarking and Certification within a region, and reduce auditor travel costs for both our members and on the environment.
