Norfolk Island 3 - DAY ITINERARY

You can't escape the history on Norfolk Island, the entire island hums with four layers of rich history.

"Dieh es awwas kamfrom" This is our heritage.

DAY 1

Join a half day tour to hear about the unique history and culture. Or pick up a visitor map & explore the fascinating UNESCO World Heritage site at Kingston.

The Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama is a 360° mural painting taking you on the HMV Bounty journey from England, Tahiti, Pitcairn to Norfolk Island. Created by local artists, this is a must see.

Be an eyewitness to the testimony of 15 extraordinary characters at the weekly Trial of the 15 Play. Boo the villains and cheer for the hero's!

DAY 2

Morning

The Museum Pass is excellent value for money. You have unlimited access to four Kingston museums, all with interesting stories to tell. The pass includes two guided tours.

Afternoon

Learn the island's unique way of life on an Island Cultural tour. Listen to the Norfolk language, meet a wood turner & enjoy a weaving & cooking demonstration.

Evening

Listen to poems recited in the Norfolk language at the Wonderland by Night show. Fairy lights and dioramas set in this natural rainforest, make for a delightful evening.

DAY 3

The convict cemetery is well worth a visit. The Headstones tell the tales of those who did not survive the harsh convict settlements. It's your choice whether to visit during the day or night!

Visit the historical St Barnabas Chapel which was built c.1880. The glorious rose stained glass window is just one of the Chapels beautiful attributes.

Don't miss the popular sunset Island fish fry, serving delicious fish, tasty salads & traditional island desserts.

STAY FOR 7 - DAYS

There is SO much to do on Norfolk Island, why not stay longer.

Witness the annual celebrations of Anniversary Bounty Day, go back in time at the Pitcairn Settlers Village, hear stories of the Pitcairn Islanders on 1856 The Untold Story tour, book a Sound and Light show, research your Convict ancestry, visit for Foundation day.
