An exciting new way to explore the natural beauty of the Northern Rivers. The Lismore to Bentley section is currently in planning with work due to commence following community consultation.

WHAT IS IT?

The Northern Rivers Rail Trail is a new walking and cycling trail that will connect the Tweed Valley with Byron Shire, Lismore and Casino, transforming a former rail corridor into the region's newest must-do experience for visitors and locals.

When completed, it will traverse 132km of some of the most spectacular and diverse countryside in Australia, winding its way through scenic villages and towns, rail tunnels and historic bridges.

It will be one of the longest rail trails in the country where walkers and cyclists of all ages will be free to explore and discover the natural beauty of the region.

The trail will be constructed in four stages as funding allows, each delivered separately by the four local councils – Tweed Shire, Byron Shire, Lismore City and Richmond Valley.


BENTLEY - SOUTH LISMORE

The 16.3km stage will connect the former South Lismore railway station with Bentley via some of the most scenic rural landscapes in the Northern Rivers. The trail will be a safe and fun way for locals and visitors alike to explore and connect with the natural beauty of our environment.

The project will tap into the rapidly growing hinterland tourism market and create exciting growth opportunities for new and existing businesses that support local jobs.

COMING SOON!

Investigation and design work is underway with community consultation occurring throughout the remainder of 2022. Once community consultation and design is undertaken, construction will commence and work is expected to be complete within two years, weather permitting. 
