# NORTHERN RIVERS RAIL TRAIL

## >> THE TWEED MURWILLUMBAH - CRABBES CREEK

An exciting new way to explore the natural beauty of the Tweed Valley. The Tweed section from Murwillumbah to Crabbes Creek, due to open in 2023, will be the first section of the Northern Rivers Rail Trail to open.

### WHAT IS IT?

The Northern Rivers Rail Trail is a new walking and cycling trail that will connect the Tweed Valley with Byron Shire, Lismore and Casino, transforming a former rail corridor into the region's newest must-do experience for visitors and locals.

When completed, the trail will traverse 132km of some of the most spectacular and diverse countryside in Australia, winding its way through scenic villages and towns, rail tunnels and historic bridges.

It will be one of the longest rail trails in the country where visitors of all ages and abilities will be free to explore and discover the natural beauty of the region.

The trail will be constructed in four stages as funding allows, each delivered separately by the four local councils – Tweed Shire, Byron Shire, Lismore City and Richmond Valley.

### MURWILLUMBAH - CRABBES CREEK 24KM

This 24km stage will connect heritage-listed Murwillumbah Railway Station with the Tweed Regional Art Gallery before it winds through the picturesque villages of Stokers Siding, Burringbar, Mooball and Crabbes Creek.

The rail trail will be a destination for the whole community to enjoy, whether you are looking for a safe place to ride or a new way to experience our beautiful countryside and villages with friends and family. It will also provide a major boost for tourism in the region, creating jobs and offering exciting new business opportunities from coffee vans, food trucks and paddock-to-plate experiences to horse riding, brewery tours and arts and craft stalls.

For locals and visitors alike, the rail trail will be a fresh way to connect with nature and explore the breathtaking beauty of the Northern Rivers, by bicycle or on foot.

Construction of the Tweed section is underway and is due to open in 2023. The sections between Casino, Bentley and South Lismore are also fully funded and work is due to commence in 2022.

The final stages of the trail, which are still subject to planning approval and funding, would link Lismore to Eltham and travel up through Byron Shire to Yelgun.
