

# COVID SAFE PLAN – OSHC

## OUR COMMITMENT

As Community Services involves close contact at times, we are at a high risk of exposure. To ensure the health and safety of our staff, our valued clients and the wider community we are taking every precaution possible to maintain a safe and hygienic environment to prevent transmission. Here at Richmond OSHC we always adhere to strict hygiene practices but at this worrying time we are going above and beyond expectation.

## GROUP ACTIVITIES

Keeping in line with Government restrictions all Centre Based Activities and Transport will be in line with Social Distancing rules. Until further notice After School Care Bus Pick Up will not be occurring. Cleaning of high touch areas will be increased and all clients and staff are encouraged to make use of the hand sanitizer at the front door. If you or your child present to OSHC with obvious signs of being unwell, you will be asked to leave.

## ATTENDING OSHC

As per our usual procedure – you must be 100% well to attend our Service. It is very important that you inform us in advance if your child or anyone in your household is unwell, or self-isolating because they are at risk of becoming unwell with COVID -19. Unfortunately, due to strict public health requirements your child/ren will be unable to attend OSCH if they, you or anyone in your household is unwell or in self-isolation. We will of course treat this information in strict confidence and your children will be welcome to attend OSHC after 14 days of being asymptomatic.

## PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND OUR CENTRE IF:

- Your child/ren have tested positive for COVID-19
- Your child/ren has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (including home or workplace)
- Your child/ren have any of the COVID-19 symptom's (fever, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, fatigue, loss of smell, upset tummy)
- Your child/ren or any family member are currently in quarantine or isolation
- Your child/ren have been in close contact with someone currently in quarantine or self-isolation
- Any person in the high risk category for serious infection from the COVID-19 pandemic (people aged over 70, immune-compromised & those diagnosed with a chronic medical condition) are recommended to assess your own risk.

## **WHEN YOU ATTEND OUR CENTRE**

- Please limit the number of people that come in collect your child/ren
- Once you enter the Centre you will see our sanitization station at the front door Please use the hand sanitizer provided.
- Please maintain 1.5 metres social distancing at all times were possible with other clients.
- Tables, chairs and other high touch areas will be sanitized and wiped over before and after use to ensure a comfortable and hygienic experience at our Centre.
