paddleboard or kayak at Gray's Bay, take a sunset stroll along Queen's Beach or run with your dogs along King's Beach.

Situated on a dramatic coastline overlooking the top of the Whitsunday Islands, Bowen hosts impressive walking trails and lookouts. Head to Horseshoe Bay and walk the coastal trail or drive to the top of Flagstaff Hill to take in the magnificent 360-degree views including our historic lighthouse on North Head Island. Keep an eye out during winter as whales make their way along the Queensland coast.

Bowen also has a rich and interesting history, depicted in murals throughout the town with the feature mural on the Bowen Water Reservoir a standout.

THINGS TO DO

MAJOR EVENTS

WHITSUNDAY FESTIVAL OF MOTORING MAY 3RD TO MAY 5TH

The Rally Whitsundays promoted by Whitsunday Sporting Car Club and Round 1 of the 2019 CAMS Queensland Rally Championship will be contested on Saturday 4 May 2019 on shire roads, private property and within the township of Bowen. Across the weekend take in Music, live acts Classic Car Parades, Displays and Show and Shines and more.

BOWEN RIVER RODEO AND CAMPDRAFT 7TH-9TH JUNE

The Bowen River Rodeo and Campdraft is held annually on the long weekend in June at the rodeo grounds behind the Bowen River Hotel. Campsites are available over the weekend & there is also plenty of live entertainment.

THE BOWEN SHOW JUNE 25TH

All the fun of the fair with rides and entertainment plus exhibits of local produce, cattle, cooking, arts and crafts.

BOWEN SUPERBOATS JULY 19TH-21ST

Bowen will again host the Offshore Superboat Championships - aka the 'Fastest Sport on No Wheels' in 2019. The Superboat Street Fest will be a highlight of the weekend on Saturday night. Saturday and Sunday the Superboats will battle it out on the beautiful Edgecumbe Bay, with great viewing from along the foreshore and surrounds.

BOWEN'S WALK TO THE LIGHTHOUSE AUGUST 31ST

The North Head Lighthouse is one of the oldest in Queensland and is connected to the mainland by a sand bar, which during the lowest winter tides becomes exposed enough for the annual 'Walk to the Lighthouse'. While your feet may get a little wet (wear reef shoes!) you will be amazed by the abundance of sea life in the shallows. Stroll past giant red starfish, watch green sea turtles dart away across the sea grass beds and feather stars uncurling and crawling away. Keep an eye on the horizon, as migrating whales often breach in the surrounding seas.

Once you return to the mainland, join the festivities as the sun sets and raise a toast to celebrate our nature, history and community.

ART AND PHOTOGRAPHY

DINING & SHOPPING

The food bowl of the north delivers wonderful fresh produce. Sampling is as easy as visiting the range of restaurants, pubs and cafes, all in excellent locations most just a few minutes' walk from your accommodation. A wander through the main business centre uncovers not only great local shopping but also a history lesson as told through the town's murals!

GOLF, TENNIS, BOWLS

Queens Beach boasts a nine-hole golf course with sweeping views of the sea. Within walking distance are also tennis courts and a bowling green. Bowen Bowls Club is on the corner of Livingstone and Gregory Streets and has a modern, shaded facility.

SUMMERGARDEN THEATRE

Summergarden Theatre in Queens Beach is a gem of Bowen's heritage, built in 1948. Merging art-deco stylings, old world charm with the newest cinema technology, going to 'the pictures' is a must-do for visitors.

BEACHES & SNORKELLING

HORSESHOE BAY 🥸 🔍

It's no surprise Horseshoe Bay is a regular at the top of 'best beaches' lists! Protected and cosy, the white sand and crystal-clear water make it one of Bowen's favourites. Just metres offshore a spectacular coral reef provides fantastic snorkelling and scuba diving. It also has an entry point to the Cape Edgecumbe Walking Trail, which links the fringing reef beaches of Horseshoe, Murray & Rose Bays.

GRAYS BAY 🥸 🥥 🥣

One of the most picturesque bays in Queensland and magnificent for sunsets over the water. Grays Bay has a boat ramp, free barbecues and a shady playground area is situated nearby. It's a popular spot for water sport, from jet-ski's to SUP.

MURRAY BAY 😂 🥄 🤇

This is a beautiful tropical bay complete with coconut trees. Access is solely down a narrow track or walking trail, but once there the outlook is incredible, and you will love spending the day exploring the secluded beach. Murray Bay is a favourite for photographers and provides excellent snorkelling, diving and fishing.

FRONT BEACH 🥸 🥝

The perfect pull up area for travellers, day-trippers and local and visiting families. The foreshore area includes community soundshell event space, Catalina Memorial and information kiosk, complete with replica Big Mango. Discover Bowen's role in the filming of the Baz Lurhmann 'Australia' and learn how they created movie magic. Families and groups can relax, with plenty of picnic areas, amenities, playgrounds, skate park and free water park for the kids. Take a walk on the wharf and catch a fish or spot a green sea turtle as they pop up to say G'day!

ROSE BAY 🥸 🗐 🥑

This sandy beach offers lovely views of Gloucester Island and Mother Beddock. The adjoining public park area is perfect for families and groups with free barbecues, picnic tables and playground. Laze under the shade of the palms or snorkel the fringing reef.

KINGS BEACH 🚳 🌒 🥱

Beautiful, undeveloped and often deserted means you can have the place all to yourself. Kings Beach's sweeping shore is also an off-leash dog friendly beach so it's the perfect spot to hang out with your best mate.





QUEENS BEACH 🥸 🍘

Strolling along the 5km stretch of Queens Bay's sandy shore offers plenty of great activities – beachcombing, fishing or just taking in the sunset. Bowen's longest beach stretches from 'The Pocket' on Horseshoe Bay Rd to Yasso Point and the Don River mouth. Along the way are several beachfront parks with free barbecues, large playgrounds and Sunday markets. Getting exercise with a view is easy with kilometres of walking and bicycle paths and free exercise equipment.


CORAL BAY 🥸 🤇

Secluded and tucked away between Horseshoe Bay and Grays Bay, the shores of this hidden spot include Bowen's clothing-optional beach. There really is a beach for everyone in Bowen! Follow the bush track or ask a local for directions!

DISCOVER FRINGING REEF FROM THE MAINLAND

Did you know? Bowen is one of the very few places on the Queensland coast where you can walk off the beach, head underwater and in 10 kicks be experiencing a living reef and an abundance of marine life. Snorkelling in Bowen is as simple as hiring or bringing your own fins, snorkel and mask and walking straight off the beach.

High tide times allow snorkelers to explore up into the rocks and swim among the bountiful fish life at Horseshoe and Murray Bay. Low tide is best for viewing hard and soft corals along the left side of Rose Bay and across the entrance of Horseshoe Bay. Among the many species you are likely to encounter, expect to see large schools of brightly coloured parrot fish that are vital to a healthy coral ecosystem.



WALKS

ONE OF THE BEST WAYS TO ENJOY BOWEN'S COASTAL SCENERY IS TO EXPLORE THE MANY BEAUTIFUL TRACKS

Winding through shady beachside parkland and taking in beautiful views, follow the wide pathway from Queens Bay around to Horseshoe Bay. Kings Beach Walk (1.8km)

An easy walk along the sandy beach, starting from the car park area below Flagstaff Hill or via the short, unsealed road off Queens Road. The beach is an off-lead area suitable for dog walking.

QUEENS BAY BEACH WALK


Follows Queens Beach from Yasso Point at the Don River mouth to Golf Links Road for beautiful views of both the bay and the suburb of Queens Beach. Alternatively follow the shared sealed bike and walking pathway.

MULLER'S LAGOON TO QUEENS BAY (3.8KM)

Includes a scenic walk around the lagoon and gardens, as well as along Soldiers Road that will take you to the beaches. Alternatively, if you are a keen bird watcher or botanist, stroll through Mullers Lagoon and enjoy the flora and fauna found within the 24 hectares of picturesque parkland.

CAPE EDGECUMBE WALKING TRAIL (2.5KM)

Taking in Horseshoe Bay, Murray Bay and Rose Bay, nature lovers will be impressed by postcard-worthy lookouts, bays and beaches and opportunities to see native wildlife and bird life. You can walk the entire circuit or just part of it and there are entry points at each of the bays. If you start at Horseshoe Bay, the track begins with a



short 100-metre uphill climb with a lookout at the top, offering breathtaking views. Continue along the main track for a few hundred metres and keep an eye out for a side path to your right, which leads to the site of a World War II radar station and anti-aircraft battery. Whilst the guns are long gone, you can still see the mounting points. Proceed through Murray Bay, continuing towards Rose Bay. There is another side path to an imposing boulder balanced precariously on a granite outcrop. This landmark, seen from many locations throughout Bowen, is Mother Beddock. From here you can walk down to Rose Bay.



6 PARK RUN BOWEN

Parkrun is a free weekly 5km timed event for both walkers and runners. We start at 7am each Saturday from Barker Park walking and running to Grays Bay before making our way through nearby parklands, Case Park and Hansen Park then finishing back at Barker Park. To register for free go to www.parkrun. com.au/register/.

BOWEN FORESHORE TO QUEENS BAY (3.5KLM)

This is easy access from the business centre to scenic bays for walkers and cyclists.

BOWEN FORESHORE & JETTY (FEW HUNDRED METRES)

Explore the Bowen foreshore, parks and Catalina memorial along sealed pathways. Step back in time with a stroll along the historic jetty. Built in 1865, it's perfect for spotting diverse marine life including turtles, dugongs and stingrays that cruise the shallows when the tide is in.

FLAGSTAFF HILL

Flagstaff Hill offers some of the best coastal views you will ever see with a 360-degree panorama of the whole Bowen region – and you won't have to walk up a hill! The lookout is an easy short drive* from the main business centre and has ample parking, making it highly accessible for all visitors. Use the binoculars for \$2 to see even more, from the Whitsundays hinterland and mountains, to Abbot Point and Bowen's rich farming land, and northern Whitsunday islands. During winter this is an ideal land-based whale watching location.

HORSESHOE BAY ROTARY LOOKOUT

Take the short hike up to the Rotary Lookout for a stellar view of one of Bowen's favourite beaches. Continuing along the Cape Edgecumbe walking trail provides access to stunning elevated views from the World War II Radar Station Lookout and Mother Beddock.

GRAYS BAY PICNIC SPOT

This accessible lookout is just a short walk from the Grays Bay car park and is a favourite for sunset dinners.

RESERVOIR HILL

Although not an official lookout, take the short drive to view the water tank murals up close via Tynwald Avenue and you will be rewarded with excellent views of the coast, town and Mullers Lagoon.

HOW TO FIND BOWEN'S MURALS





EVERY TOWN HAS IT'S OWN UNIQUE STORY BOWEN'S HISTORY, CULTURE, NATURE AND HERITAGE ARE TOLD THROUGH OVER 28 MURALS THAT ADORN BUSINESSES ACROSS THE TOWN.

Many murals adorn the walls of buildings throughout town, from historical scenes to vibrant depictions of our region and community. Keep an eye out for the water tank murals and their iconic Bowen scenes, visible from many angles as you explore the town.



BOWEN'S WATER TANK

Standing tall above the landscape of Bowen, visitors can't miss the bright scenes that adorn our town reservoir tanks. Once sporting the 'Bowenwood' signage (a homage to the town's movie making days during the filming of Baz Lurhmann's Australia), the community, council and local tourism organisation came together to give our water tanks a colourful face lift in 2018. The result, featuring icons of the region from the famous Bowen Mango, to historic North Head Lighthouse and sailing across the blue waters of the Whitsundays, are a must see.



THE REGIONS QUILT

A tourist attraction that should not be missed is hanging in the Bowen Library, Herbert Street. This is a masterpiece in stitching and was created by the Bowen Quilters and Needlecraft Group depicting the Whitsundays Region's history and attractions. It took 1426 hours of combined stitching by the group.

FISHING

BOAT RAMPS

Public boat ramps can be found at the Bowen Boat Harbour (all tide, multi lane and includes pontoon walkway), Grays Bay and at the mouth of the Don River at Yasso Point, Queens Beach. Yasso Point boat ramp is only accessible high tide, not suitable for large craft.

FISHING

Fishing is one of Bowen's biggest attractions, with its numerous creek systems, coral studded islands, offshore reefs, and most importantly, abundant fish life.

OFFSHORE FISHING

Bowen has a multitude of offshore fishing spots, including the fringing reefs around our inshore islands. These islands range between 1 and 18 NM from the Bowen Harbour and are named North Head, Stone, Middle, Gloucester and Holbourne. They all have abundant reef for both line and spear fishing.

IN THE REGION

A short drive north of Bowen, Molongle Creek offers great fishing, as well as access to Cape Upstart National Park that is only accessible by boat. If you have the time, you really should plan to stay for a few days, and Molongle Creek Tourist Caravan Park is worth considering. To get there turn right off the Bruce Highway onto Molongle Beach Road only 55 kilometres north of Bowen. The park caters for all who love fishing and crabbing and there's plenty of parking for boats. The Molongle



Creek Boat Club offers modern facilities and they are open to the public. There are four boat ramps that are well maintained all year round. Beside the ramps is a huge multipurpose area that includes showers, toilets, and a large covered area fitted out with barbecues. The club is continually working to improve access. The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park surrounds Cape Upstart National Park and is only accessible by boat.

DON'T HAVE A BOAT?

There are plenty of land-based options including the Bowen Jetty, the rocks at the southern end of Kings Beach and the rocky outcrops at Horseshoe, Grays and Rose Bay. Whiting are caught around the mouths in the town area including Magazine Creek near the boat harbour, Doughty's Creek at the western edge of town and Sandhills Creek at Kings Beach.







BOWEN HISTORICAL MUSEUM TIME







PORT OF ABBOT POINT

The Port of Abbot Point is Australia's most northern coal export port and one with remarkable potential for trade growth.

In naturally deep water, the port is located 25 kilometres north of Bowen and incorporates the Adani Abbot Point Terminal (AAPT) with a current export capacity of 50 million tonnes per annum.

For the 2016-17 financial year it achieved export figures of 25.4 million tonnes of coal and handled 311 ships.



Bowen is Queensland's second largest exporter of live coral trout and this industry is worth over \$20 million to the local economy The red colour of our fish makes them the most sought after by the Chinese and the market price can vary from \$32 to \$64kg. The Bowen harbour has 2 unloading facilities that both sell to the local market. Aquaculture is also an important industry in the region with the Good Fortune Bay Fisheries operation north of Bowen producing 1500 tonnes of fin fish annually including Barramundi.

GRAZING

More than 25 million hectares in the Bowen Collinsville region produces beef cattle.

The local grazing community is actively working at reducing impact on the Great Barrier Reef. NQ Dry Tropics is leading the Landholders Driving Change project, a three-year program to pilot cost-effective solutions to keep soil on the land, reduce run-off to the reef, and to help achieve enduring, sustainable and productive land management.

Graziers are fully involved in the process of designing projects to improve their land and reduce sediment run-off. The project is trialling a range of innovative landscape repair options, some tried and tested, some new. It means graziers have clear ownership of its outcomes.

Landholders Driving Change is one of two Major Integrated Projects (MIPs) recommended by the Great Barrier Reef Water Science Taskforce and funded by the Queensland Government through the Queensland Reef Water Quality Program. If it works well, this new model of program delivery may be transferred to other catchments in the reef community.



SALT WORKS

Bowen' solar evaporation salt field and refinery at the entrance to the town began operating in 1925. It is one of a number owned and operated by Australian Saltworks. The operation supplies customers in the stockfeed, swimming pool, water treatment and industrial markets in Qld, NSW & NT. It is the northernmost salt field in Australia.

FARMWORK

For backpackers and other visitors seeking farm work Bowen offers a great location, with plenty of opportunities and accommodation options, as well as a laid-back beachside location to enjoy. Accommodation includes hostels, affordable caravan parks and guest houses and many may also be able to help you find work and provide transport.

Some things to note: Be aware that weather plays an important role in harvesting, from affecting start days to creating shortages. If it rains work may not be available and your income may be temporarily affected. Wages are generally based on the volume of crop picked rather than the number of hours worked.

Although experience is not always necessary, it is important to remember that getting your '88 days' can mean early starts and labour intensive work in hot and dusty conditions. Be prepared with adequate sun and insect protection and stay hydrated.

HORTICULTURE PRODUCTS

The Bowen and Gumlu region is the largest winter growing vegetable region in Australia and supplies both the domestic and export markets with produce to the value of \$450 million dollars. The major commodities grown sice the 1930's to this day are tomatoes, capsicums, mangoes, beans, sweet corn, melons and eggplant. The industry employs over 3200 skilled and unskilled workers during the season with a wide variety of career opportunities.

For your own health and safety and to respect farm biosecurity, follow all signage when visiting farms.

Bowen sits in the northern section of the Whitsundays, a 45 minute drive from Airlie Beach and Whitsunday Resort islands and is halfway between North Queensland's major cities, Mackay and Townsville. Collinsville is located 85km inland from Bowen, about a 45 minute drive. It is situated at the foothills of the Clarke Range. The turn-off to Collinsville is about a 10 minute drive north of Bowen off the Bruce Highway. It is clearly signposted.

AIR

Access is via the major airports of Whitsunday Coast (Proserpine) and Hamilton Island. The Mackay and Townsville airports are a 2-hour drive from Bowen. The Whitsunday Coast Airport is a 50 minute drive from Bowen and has plenty of car parking and a rental car park.

Rail Queensland Rail's "Spirit of Queensland" services provide regular connections into Bowen.

Coach services connect from Bowen daily and provide north and southbound services.



A SCENIC TOUR AROUND TROPICAL Bowen

ENJOY the scenic delights of Bowen by following the Golden No Tour prepared for you by members of the Rotary Club of Bowen. Your tour starts at 1 which is sited some 200 metres on the town side of the Bowen Salt Works.

Proceed via (2), (3) on Leichhardt Street.

4 is located at the intersection of Herbert and Livingstone Streets. Proceed via Herbert Street and the town's business centre with its wide streets and centre garden plots.

5, located at Santa Barbara Parade. Continue from No 5 along the harbour foreshore to 6

6 located at the roundabout, travelling through the roundabout, your tour will take you via 📿 and 8 to Flagstaff Hill Lookout.

The view from the summit gives panoramic views of the harbour and surrounding islands. However, because of the steep gradient, it is not suitable for caravans. Retrace your journey back via Nos 8, 7 and 6 to 9 which will lead you back to the intersection of Herbert St and Santa Barbara Parade, then proceed along the main shopping centre to No 10.

10 and 11, will take you past the State High School and the Showgrounds, to (2) at the base of Mount Nutt Lookout. Unfortunately, here you must leave your vehicle and walk to top. The scenic view from the base of the water tower lookout commands views of the many small crop farms and mango plantations which contribute to the town's economy. In the distance, the offshore coal handling facilities of Abbot Point can be seen.

(13), continues through the beachside suburb of Queens Beach via (4) to (9).

20, you will pass the Bowen Golf Club nestling along the shores of Queens Beach.

BOWEN STREET DIRECTORY INDEX

21 turns into Wests Lane, your journey continues past the Bowen Old People's Homes Society Nursing Home, Hostel, Day Therapy Centre and Rotary Village.

On the opposite side of the road is Cunningham Villas, once a retirement home for ex-servicemen and women. It is now open to all.

22 to 35 will provide you with a tour of picturesque Horseshoe Bay, just one of the many beautiful bays which are ideal for swimming or sunbaking all year round. The view from Rotary Lookout is something which should not be missed. Retracing your journey back to 26, your tour will continue to Rose Bay and the magnificent view of Gloucester Island and Kings Beach. Your tour will then return via 🔊 to 30 where it will end at Mullers Lagoon with its abundant wild birdlife.




MOTORING



THIS IS BOWEN'S VERY FIRST FIRE ENGINE WHICH WAS PURCHASED IN 1923 BY THE BOWEN FIRE BRIGADE BOARD. In 2003 a vintage car collector knowing it's history offered it for sale to the Bowen community and The Bowen Independent purchased it for \$4000 and formed a committee under the leadership of the then mayor Mike Brunker for it's restoration. It was then presented back to the Bowen community in good working condition and is on show at many public events. It can be viewed at the Bowen Independent office 28 George Street, Bowen during working hours.





COLLINSVILLE

THE HISTORIC MINING TOWN OF COLLINSVILLE IS LOCATED 85KM WEST OF BOWEN, ABOUT A 45 MINUTE DRIVE, SITUATED IN THE FOOTHILLS OF THE CLARKE RANGE. THE COLLINSVILLE DEVELOPMENTAL ROAD WILL TAKE YOU INLAND TO AN AREA RICH IN COAL MINING AND GRAZING HISTORY.

The Collinsville area was opened up as a grazing run in early 1861, Strathmore Station being the first in the district. During the 1880s several gold mines were operated at Ukalunda, My Wyatt, and Normandy and later at Mt Coolon.

In 1865, reports of a large coal deposit at Moongunya resulted in extensive testing and mining eventuated in 1919. The area was renamed Collinsville in 1921. The main township of Collinsville was established in late 1922 when 20 homes were erected. The State School and Police quarters were already operational, as were a general store and butcher shop and bakery.

A hospital opened in 1926 and the town received reticulated water in 1930, with electricity connected in 1947. In 1967 a powerhouse was opened. It closed in 1988, was later privatised and reopened in 1997 and closed again in 2013. While in town, stroll around and look for the historical mining murals and heritage signs that will provide an insight into the lives of the region's early settlers. A visit to the Miners Memorial and Coalface Experience Museum is a must.

Visit the Collinsville Bakery for their famous fresh bread, stroll downtown and delight in locally made Arts and Crafts or simply enjoy a delicious cup of coffee.

There is a pleasant 3.7 km walkway from Collinsville to Scottville that provides easy walking or biking for those who want a bit of exercise.

Collinsville's latest tourist attraction is the Pit Pony Experience which celebrates the lives of Australia's last working mine Pit Ponies. Retired in 1990, Wharrier and Mr Ed marked the end of a long history of miners and pit ponies working side by side as mates.

Centred around a a life size Collinsville Pit Pony sculptured in bronze, the Pit Pony Experience acknowledges the contribution from the community on a donaters wall located behind the horse. Around town are various"selfie" walls where visitors and locals alike can picture themselves along side the loved pit ponies. A tourist route via a smartphone app has also been established through the small town to show off local attractions and to assist local business. The Pit Pony Experience is a true reflection of the strong values of comradeship and community found in Collinsville.





VISITOR INFORMATION

The Visitor Information Centre is now

located near the new RV Area in the Collinsville Showgrounds for the convenience of our visitors. Make this your first stop, for brochures and information on what to do and where to go.

The Collinsville and Scottville District Historical Society's historical display is situated alongside the Community Hub and local Centrelink agency.



COAL FACE MUSEUM

Collinsville's Mining Heritage Centre, the Coalface Experience, is dedicated to the history of Queensland's coal mining industry and showcases

the rich mining heritage of the region.

Stories of struggle, strife and mateship are played out at a range of interactive displays, audio-visual exhibits, two theatrettes and historical records presenting visitors with a great interpretation of the past, present and future of Queensland's coal mining industry.

The museum also shows visitors what life was like for the coal miners, both above and below ground in the 1950s.

The museum's opening coincided with the 50th anniversary of the town's biggest underground mining disaster, in which seven men were killed in an underground gas outburst on October 13, 1954. It honours those men, and 19 others who have also lost their lives on the Collinsville coalfield. Collinsville was recognised as a potential coalfield as early as 1866, when the area became known as the Bowen River Coalfield.

Railway construction from Bowen started in 1917 and full scale coal production started in 1922 following the railway's completion that provided access to coastal markets.



BOWEN RIVER HOTEL - STRATHMORE PUB

Originally established in about 1861, the building was donated to the National Trust of Queensland in 1974 by Ted Cunningham, of Strathmore Station. It was abandoned for sometime but in 2003 was rebuilt and now comprises of two buildings connected by a covered walkway. The building is an example of careful bush carpentry and skilled joinery. The hotel has a licensed bar, an informal beer garden that is family friendly and serves lunch and dinner. Accommodation is also available. There's also a collection of photographs, paper clippings and memorabilia from early years.

The immediate surrounds are abundant with wildlife and fish in the Bowen River are plentiful. Camping is offered for a small donation near the hotel.

Every year in May, a fishing competition is hosted at nearby Terrible Creek. The Bowen River Rodeo and Campdraft is held on a weekend in June.

MINERS MEMORIAL DAY

Miners Memorial Day is held every year on the 13th October, in memory of the 26 men that have lost their lives in the Collinsville mines. The memorial is held at the Workers Club, Home of the Coal Face Experience. October 13 is the day of Collinsville's worst disaster which occurred in 1954, when 7 men tragically lost their lives in an underground outburst.

FREE 72 HOUR CARAVAN / RV REST AREA



Collinsville offers a 72 hour FREE Caravan & RV Rest Area in the Showgrounds.

The rest area includes access to potable water, a dump point and shower & toilets with disabled capabilities. Collinsville's historical mining heritage trail is a must on your inland journey.





CREEK PICNICS

Have a picnic on the banks of any of our local creeks. The creeks usually have a good flow in them during the April-Nov wet season.

• 3 Mile Creek 3 Mile Creek is part of the Pelican Creek system and is located 15 minutes west of town as you travel through Scottville and out along the Myuna Road. It's a great little swimming hole and picnic area.

• **Pelican Creek** Pelican Creek is a nice little creek that runs from the north east of town round to the western area. It's easily accessible from several locations.

• **40 Foot** 40 Foot is nestled up in the heart of Mt Devlin and in the wet season puts on a lovely waterfall display. A 15 to 20-minute hike up Mt Devlin will see you at the waterfall.

• **Terry's Creek** Terry's Creek is a 15-minute drive along the Peter Delemothe Road towards Bowen. It is another popular picnic and swimming place in the wet season.



MT COOLON HOTEL

This is a great old pub with heaps of character and memorabilia, they offer a dinner menu, and has rooms for the weary driver. Phone (07) 4983 5530.

MURALS

Several Murals, depicting historic figures and scenes of historical mining activities, are painted on local business walls and contribute to the street beautification scheme.

The latest Murals illustrate the importance of the Pit Pony to this unique mining community and the Coal industry in general and are part of a larger mural project linking Collinsville and Bowen.



BOWEN RIVER WEIR

Bowen River Weir is about a 20-minute drive from Collinsville. Take the Mt Coolon Road out of town and when you get to Sonoma Mine, the turn-off to the weir is on the left hand side, opposite the mine's entrance. The road can be rough at times so drive to the road conditions. The weir is a popular fishing and camping spot and the local fish stocking association restock the weir with barramundi fingerlings each year.

The Collinsville water supply is pumped from here and is controlled by Sunwater. Be aware, saltwater crocodiles do inhabit these waters.



HERITAGE SIGN TRAIL

The local historical society has sign marked a few of the Historical sites and buildings around the Collinsville, Scottville and Mt Coolon Districts. Each sign has a picture and a description of the significance of the site.




MT COOLON

Mount Coolon is famous for its Gold mining history, its pioneering grazing families and their experiences under harsh conditions. Mount Coolon is on the intersection of the Bowen Developmental Road and the Suttor Developmental Road. Approximately 124 km from Collinsville. Only 75km of the road is bitumen sealed.

A jackeroo called Luke Reynolds from Yacamunda Station discovered gold there in 1913. Thomas Coolon was the first to peg a claim in 1914. Today the town boasts an array of old buildings and ruins to capture the imagination.


