All of East Arnhem Land is Aboriginal land, which means it is private land but Traditional Owners welcome visitors to travel the region. In most circumstances a permit is required to travel by road through Aboriginal land, to enter or visit an Aboriginal community or homeland, and to visit camping and recreational areas in East Arnhem Land.
