Yuntulun Kuli-war

Exhibition at Signal Point Gallery

In July 2021, Alexandrina Council received grant funding from the Australian Government under the Murray-Darling Basin Economic Development Program (round three) to create and immersive and regionally significant experience centre at Signal Point. The focus of this exhibition is Ngarrindjeri history and living culture, colonial heritage and education focussing on the importance of river health.

During an eighteen month process of co-design with the Ngarrindjeri Aboriginal Corporation, local community leaders and Exhibition Studios Yuntulun Kuli;war (coming together on the headland) has been created and installed within the refurbished iconic Signal Point building.

Bee-stung lips is the first major survey exhibition of Barbara Hanrahan's prolific thirty-year printmaking career that was set in motion in 1960 and ended with her untimely death at the age of fifty two. Characterised by playfully complex narratives that draw on both personal experience and fantasy, her works are fearlessly direct and unashamedly decorative in style.
