VOLUNTEERS are sought to join the Friends of the Oscar W Inc. and register with the Alexandrina Council.

We have around 70 active volunteers who do a wonderful job, but we always need new volunteers to come on board and share in the work and the fun.

WHAT WE DO:

Every Wednesday we work on boat maintenance, painting, welding, cleaning, timber maintenance and replacement; whatever is needed to maintain the vessel.

Another crew ('The Wood Fairies') cut dry timber on surrounding farms, split it mechanically in the wood yard and transport wood to the boat as needed.

PS Oscar W is crewed entirely by volunteers and every cruise needs 7 crew – Qualified Skipper, Mate, Steam Engineer, Fireman/Stoker and three Deckhands. Training and experience is provided at all levels.

Our members also help to run the Goolwa Riverboat Centre on the wharf. The Riverboat Centre provides historic interpretation of the Goolwa Riverport, river history and sell appropriate souvenirs and merchandise. Staff also help facilitate bookings and ticketing on Oscar W cruises.

Our group not only works together—we also have fun together. Three times each year we have a 'Friend's Day Out' cruise on the boat for members and also have an annual members 'PicNic on the Wharf' in December.
