Horse Health Declaration Forms: These forms are to be filled out and handed in only on your arrival to our show; please do not send this form in with your nominations stabling camping etc. These forms are to ensure us that your horse to the best of your knowledge is fit and well and showing no signs of sickness, therefore you must hand them in on your arrival.

GENERAL REGULATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WILL BE ENFORCED, AND COMPETITORS ARE ASKED TO CO-OPERATE AND TO AVOID ANY DELAY TO THE RING PROGRAM.

- **COMPETITORS** are to abide by Chief Ring Steward, Ringmaster, Marshalling & Equestrian Stewards' directions at all times as well as the Laws of the Queensland Agricultural Society & The T.P. A. & M. Ass. Inc. and to any Special conditions imposed by the T.P.A. & M. Ass. Inc. The Association, Steward, Servant, Agent or Volunteer of the Association WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for any accident caused through or by any exhibit or its handler. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the T.P.A. & M. Ass. Inc. and any steward agent servant or volunteer of the Association blameless and indemnified against legal proceedings. The Association will not hold itself responsible for any loss, damage to or wrong delivery of any exhibit. All exhibitors should be aware that the show includes a variety of entertainment and events, such as fireworks, motor bike exhibitions, etc. which may cause a disturbance to your animals. The exhibitor is reminded that they are responsible for taking the necessary steps to ensure the safety of their animals throughout the duration of the show. Exhibitors are also reminded that they will be held liable for any damage caused by their animals to property or person throughout the duration of their stay on the grounds. All Exhibits, on the day of entry, must be the bona fide property of Exhibitor (except in family groups) who may be required to sign a Declaration to that effect.

- **HORSES/PONIES** may not be tied to any part of the grounds fences or yards (neither inside nor outside the ring) except in those yards that have been made available for that purpose.

- **TICKET SYSTEM** of nomination will apply. Entry to classes can be purchased on the days of competition from the show office and by prepayment when ordering and paying for stables & camping. Forms are included in the schedule and are available from the show office before & during the show. Entry cards must be purchased prior to competition in bulk form (e.g. if competitor intends to enter 14 classes - purchase 14 cards). When the respective class is called, the entry card is given to the Ring Steward. No Card - No Entry - No Excuses.

Any tickets left from this must be returned & refunded before the end of the show

- **ENTRY WRISTBANDS** Competitors entering on the day of the show will be allocated with wristband passes which will be available at the Secretaries Office upon purchase

of Entry Cards for those that require them. Gate will be open from 6.30am. Competitors entry passes will be issued as followed.

1 horse	= 1 pass
2 or 3 horses	= 2 passes
4 or more horses	= 3 passes

Any other drivers or passengers in the vehicle will be required to pay entry fees or produce Membership / Pre-purchased passes to gate security at the time of entry. For those that have Pre-nominated your passes and cards will be available for collection from Secretaries Office.

- **PRIZE MONEY** Prize Money will be given out on completion of the Event from the Secretaries Office on production of an entry card signed by the Ring Steward or Judge. Prize Money is as stated. All Prize Money not collected during the Show will be forfeited.

PRIZE MONEY - If less than 3 entries per class only 1st prize money will be paid.

- **ENTRY TO CLASSES: PRESENTATION OF TICKETS**

Showing the value of required entry fee to Steward on entering the ring to compete. The Committee reserves the right to amend, cancel, or refuse entry without giving the reason for doing so. Stewards of any class section may transfer exhibits entered in the wrong class into the correct class

- **EXHIBITORS PASSES** will be issued by application. Free passes limited to one per three horses or less. Extra passes must be purchased from the Secretary.

- **STALLS & CAMPING** Plans will be displayed at the Office. Stalls are limited; we ask that you be mindful of fellow competitors and only book and pay for stalls needed to house your horses, any stalls found to be used for other purposes will be reallocated by the committee.

- **STALLS** will be allocated in strict order of application and payment. Stable bookings have been taken in previous years creating a stable shortage when those exhibitors did not attend the Show **NO PAYMENT NO STABLES**. When booking more than three stables extra horses/ponies may be allocated yards to be fair to other competitors needing stalls

- **STABLING FEES** - \$10 per stall, Stallion Stall \$12.00 Plus \$10 refundable key deposit. A cleaning fee of \$20 per stall will be levied if stables are not left raked and clean.

- **CAMPING FEE** - \$35.00 for the duration of the show, no reservation will be made without payment received. Camping tags will be provided and must be prominently displayed on the camp.

- **RIDING ATTIRE: IN ALL RIDING CLASSES & JUMPING EVENTS** Dress Rules as per the E.A. and any Rules stipulated by the Show Committee will apply. Suitable footwear AND APPROVED SAFETY HEADGEAR will be required at all times including when attending to the practice jump. Any PERSONS acting as holders for led classes will not be permitted to enter the ring unless they have signed an indemnity form from the secretary's office. Any person wishing to wear a top hat must sign an indemnity form. All riders are required to be neatly and appropriately attired whilst in the assembly yard or the judging rings in the main arena. Shorts, singlets, thongs and similar attire are not permitted. Hats or English dress caps (tweed caps) may be worn by all male and female handlers in the judging rings. Ball Caps are not permitted. Junior riders under 17yrs to wear jodhpurs boots only, in all rider classes, pony hack classes and junior hack classes. Any person who, in the opinion of the Marshalling Steward is not suitably attired with correct saddlery for the class shall be excluded from entering the main arena or competing in an event.

- **COMPETITORS PLEASE BE READY** for all classes, according to program and at times advised by the stewards. Parents -Coaches- Grooms may not enter the ring unless accompanying Children under the age of 6 years in rider classes. One leader only. This will be strictly enforced. Please co-operate and do not attempt to enter the ring.

PARENTS, COACHES, GROOMS attending to the practice jump must leave the ring before their child/ rider competes.

- **HORSE/PONY REGISTRATION PAPERS** must be available for inspection on request by Stewards. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

- **IN AWARDING CHAMPIONSHIPS:** the judges will be required to select the next animal or rider in order of merit, to be called 'Reserve which may, if the Judges consent, take the place of the champion in the event of the Champion being disqualified for any reason.

- **PERSONS EXHIBITING A REGISTERED HORSE/PONY:** as an unregistered exhibit or vice versa will be disqualified. Persons knowingly entering an exhibit in a class for which it is not eligible will be disqualified.

- **UNREGISTERED HORSE/ PONY:** to clarify this rule, this means THAT NO horse/pony that has been registered with a Breed or Colour Society at any time during its life may enter this class.

- **ALL EXHIBITS PARADED** in any section must be under complete control, stewards reserve the right to request the handler / rider of any animal to leave the ring to ensure the safety of other exhibits, competitors, handlers.

- **SPORTING EVENTS** will be run under Charters Towers Horse Sporting Club. Helmets must be worn by all competitors.

- **NO PERSON / HORSE / PONY** under disqualify action recognized by the Society may Exhibit or Compete.

- **STALLIONS** may only compete in classes that state they are eligible. Stallions may not be ridden, driven, or handled by persons under 18 years of age and must wear a bit and chain for all led classes.

CLASSIFICATION:

- **PONY HACKS** not to exceed 14hh and to be ridden by a boy or girl 16 years & under.

- **RIDING PONIES & SADDLE PONIES** not to exceed 14.2hh (ponies up to height of 14.2hh can compete in these classes) but over 14hh cannot enter the Pony Ring to compete, must compete in Galloway Ring.

- **GALLOWAY HACKS** over 14hh not exceeding 15hh may be ridden persons of any age.

- **LADIES GALLOWAY HACK** must be ridden by a female any age

- **HACKS** over 15hh may be ridden by persons of any age.

- **LADIES HACK** must be ridden by a female 17 years & over.

- **MAIDEN HACK** Horse/Galloway/Pony means they have not won a first placing at any Agricultural Show in a similar competition.
- **NOVICE HACK** Horse/Galloway/Pony means they have not won an open class or Championship at any Agricultural Show.
- **PLEASURE HACK** classes must be ridden in a plain snaffle, no spurs whips or dropped nose band.
- **LOCAL HACK** Horse/Galloway/Pony/Rider means permanent resident & owned within the Charters Towers Regional Council area for a period of six months prior to the show.
- **DISTRICT HACK** Horses/Galloways/Ponies/ Riders means they have resided in the district for six months or more preceding the forthcoming show radius of Charters Towers. Refer to District Map
- **HUNTER RULES:** Competitors Please Note Horses shown as Hacks may not compete as Hunter Hacks.
 - Snaffle Bit Bridles only are allowed in both sections
 - Boots are optional for the jumping section only
 - No change of saddle is allowed between sections
 - Whips to be a maximum length of 75cm
 - Stallions are not eligible

SHOWJUMPING

JUMPING COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- All events will be run under current **EA GUIDELINES** unless otherwise stated
- **PCAQ** members are required to present their current membership number when entering or they are not allowed to compete in PCAQ jumping events.
- **JUNIOR RIDERS** (under 18) are not permitted to ride age group & open events on the same horse. They can enter 1 horse in age group classes and another horse in the open – 18 years and over events.
- All events will be jumped out to decide the final places. If by any circumstance an event cannot be completed, the committee reserve the right to decide what, if any, prize money will be awarded
- Parents, grooms or coaches may not enter the ring unless they are acting as practice jump helpers, however they **MUST** leave the ring immediately when the competitor enters the competition ring.
- **LOCAL EVENTS** are to be locally owned and ridden. (Local being defined as within the Charters Towers Regional Council Boundaries, must have permanently resided in the area for 6 months prior to the show.
- **DISTRICT EVENTS** shall mean within an approximate 250kms radius of Charters Towers.
- **ENTRY TICKETS** are needed to be able to compete in the event.

NO ENTRY TICKET NO START

- **Horses may only compete in THREE height classes in the same jump event, irrespective of riders (excluding feature events)**
- Excessive whipping/spurring/rein pulling will not be tolerated and offenders will be disqualified from the event and all future jumping events at this show.
- Horses competing in junior feature event(s) cannot compete also in same open feature events – however junior riders are eligible to ride open on a different horse.
- The Committee reserves the right to change events to suit nominations received.
- **PRIZE MONEY - If less than 3 entries per class only 1st prize money will be paid.**
- **Junior riders who ride in their age group on horse/s in classes – 1,2,4,5,7,8,10 & 11 CAN NOT ride the same horse/s in classes 3,6,9,12,13,14,14,16,17,18,19,20,21,22,23,24**
- **Competitors Please Note: there will be no HC show jumping**

- The horsemanship class is designed to evaluate the rider's ability to execute, in concert with their horse, a set of manoeuvres prescribed by the judge with precision and smoothness while exhibiting poise and confidence, and maintaining a balanced, functional, and fundamentally correct body position. The ideal horsemanship pattern is extremely precise with the rider and horse working in complete unison, executing each manoeuvre with subtle aids and cues.
- It is mandatory that the judge post any pattern(s) to be worked at least one (1) hour prior to the commencement of the class; however, if the judge requires additional work of exhibitors for consideration of final placing, the pattern may be posted. Pattern(s) should be designed to test the horseman's ability. All ties will be broken at the judge's discretion.

CLASS PROCEDURES:

All exhibitors must enter the ring and then work individually or each exhibitor may be worked from the gate individually. When exhibitors are worked individually from the gate, a working order is required. Exhibitors are to be instructed to either leave the arena, fall into line, or fall into place on the rail after their work. The whole class, or just the finalists must work at all three (3) gaits at least one direction of the arena.

The following manoeuvres are acceptable in a pattern: walk, jog, trot, extended trot, lope, or extended lope in a straight line, curved line, serpentine, circle, or figure 8, or combination of these gaits and manoeuvres; stop; back in a straight or curved line; turn or pivot, including spins and rollbacks on the haunches and/or on the forehand; side pass, two track, or leg yield; flying or simple change of lead; counter canter; or any other manoeuvre. A back will be asked for at some time during the class. Judges will not ask exhibitors to mount or dismount.

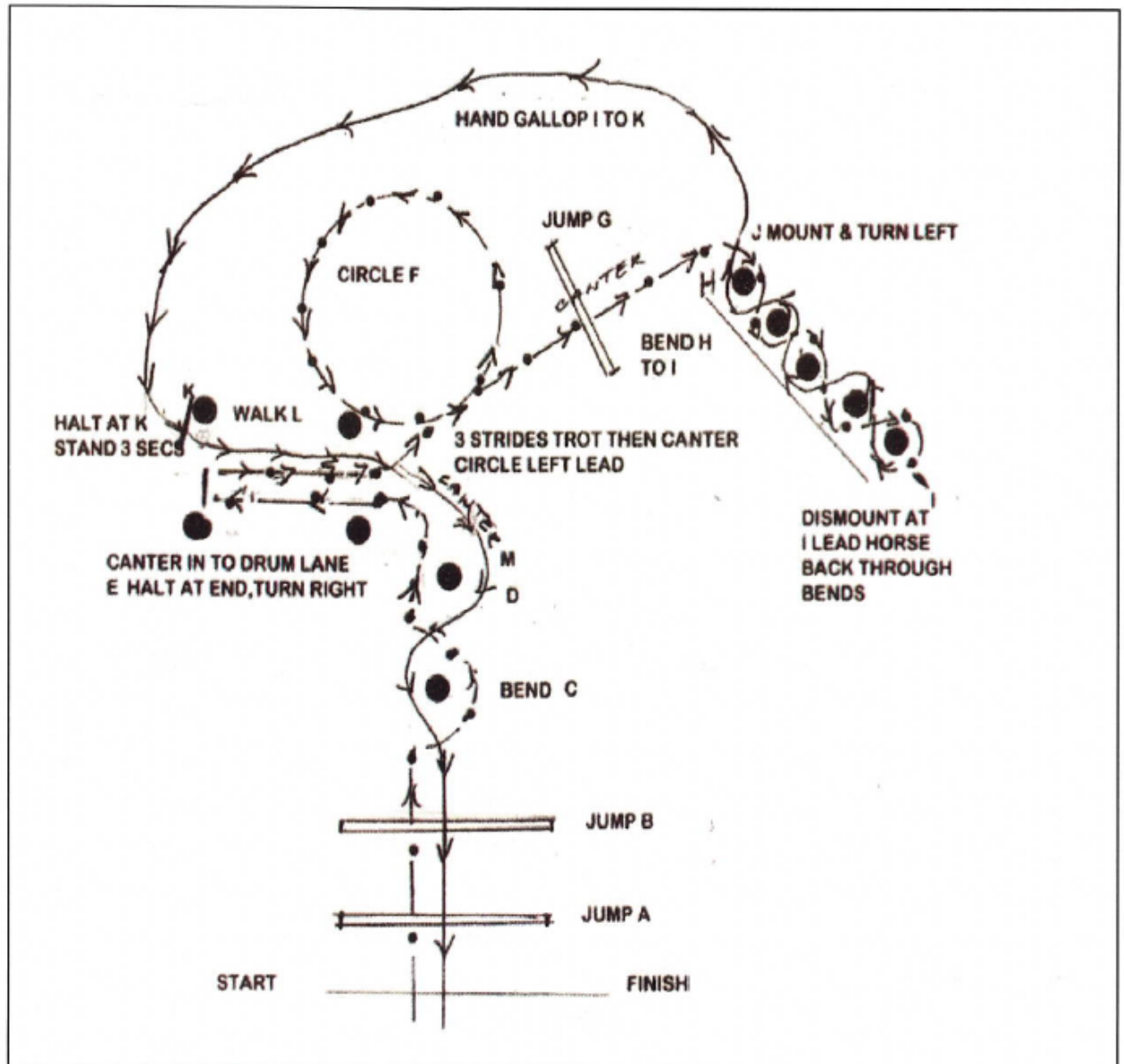

ALL AGE CHALLENGE PATTERN

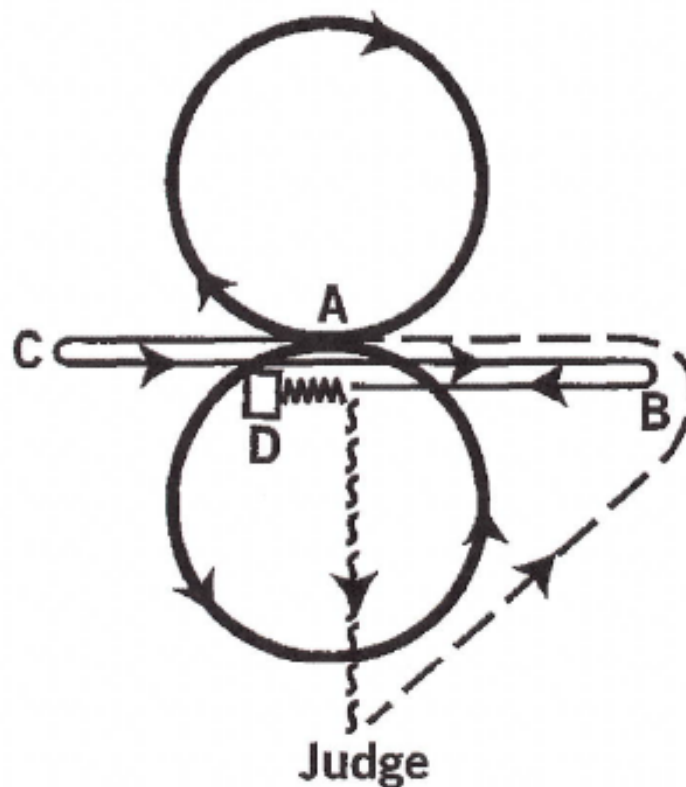
