PRIVACY

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- Anyone objecting to an award or to an exhibit in these competitions can enter a protest.
- Protest must be in writing, setting out the grounds for objection.
- Objection must be lodged with the Secretary before noon on Tuesday before the end of the Show.
- All protests must be accompanied by reasons for the protest and a \$50 deposit.
- Objection will be considered by the Dispute Resolution Committee (DRC) made up of the President, Secretary and one (1) Executive Management Committee member.
- Dispute Resolution Committee (DRC) will make enquiries and report back to the parties with a decision and the reason for the decision.
- If the Committee finds the protest frivolous or vexatious, then it can order the \$50 forfeited and put towards next year's Show prizes.
- Committee's decision is final.

ILLEGAL ITEMS
