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## DAY 1: ARRIVAL & ORIENTATION

### Afternoon | Arrival & Settling In

Arriving in Kununurra - by road or air - introduces visitors to the vast scale of the East Kimberley. Guests settle into riverside or township accommodation and ease into the region's slower rhythm. A walk along Lake Kununurra offers first encounters with local birdlife and the freshwater environment shaped by the Ord River Scheme.

### Evening | Welcome to Kununurra

Sunset signals the beginning of "Kununurra time." Dinner at the Pumphouse, set on the water's edge, combines local hospitality with heritage atmosphere. The focus is not activity, but arrival - allowing guests to transition fully into the landscape.

## DAY 3: LAKE ARGYLE OVERNIGHT

### Morning | Breathtaking Landscape

Breakfast at Kimberley café fuels the day. From there, the journey to Lake Argyle unfolds with local interpretation, sharing the pioneering history, pastoral heritage, and engineering significance of the Ord River Scheme. Along the way, vast horizons and red escarpments provide a powerful sense of scale - placing the landscape, and its stories, into perspective.

### Late Morning | Exploration

Boat tours and short walks reveal the lake's island-dotted expanse and ecological importance. The infinity pool experience visually merges water, sky and escarpment - a defining East Kimberley moment.

### Afternoon | Home Away from Home

Dinner at Lake Argyle Resort is followed by an overnight stay. Minimal artificial light allows for extraordinary stargazing. The quiet and openness offer a rare opportunity for true stillness, deepening the emotional

## DAY 2: SCALE & STILLNESS

### Morning | Awe & Wonder

An early scenic flight over Lake Argyle and the World Heritage-listed Purnululu National Park reveals the Kimberley's immense scale. From above, the Bungle Bungle Range and winding Ord River system demonstrate the ancient geology and remoteness that define the region.

### Late Morning | Fuel for the Day

Brunch at a local Wild Mango café offers a relaxed pause after the morning's aerial perspective, allowing guests to settle back into Kununurra's easy rhythm.

### Afternoon | Water-Based Restoration

A self-guided BBQ pontoon cruise on Lake Kununurra provides contrast to the morning's scale. Guests swim, observe birdlife, and enjoy a relaxed late lunch on the water. This slower, immersive experience fosters connection - to nature and to one another.

### Evening | Recovery

A restful evening prepares guests for the next day's extended journey.

## DAY 4: CULTURE & CONNECTION

### Morning | Grounding in Country

Returning to Kununurra, guests begin by connecting with Country. A visit to Waringarri Aboriginal Arts offers cultural insight at its source, or a guided walk through Mirima National Park reveals a sandstone landscape layered with meaning. Interpretive storytelling introduces the Miriwoong people as Traditional Owners, linking ancient geology with living culture and ongoing custodianship.

### Late Morning | Community & Creativity

Brunch at Blak Tapas showcases Indigenous-inspired cuisine and contemporary local produce - an expression of culture through food. From there, a visit to Artlandish Art Gallery provides the opportunity to experience and support Indigenous artists whose works reflect the stories and spirit of the region.

### Afternoon | Reflection & Perspective

Guests depart with more than photographs. They leave with an embodied sense of scale, cultural awareness, and connection to land and water - hallmarks of the East Kimberley experience.
