VISITOR PERMIT

Kalumburu is a **remote Aboriginal community**, and **ALL visitors must obtain a valid permit** before entering. Entering without a permit is considered trespassing and may result in removal from the community. Some service providers are exempt from paying permits, please contact the corporation office to check if you are included.

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL (RECOMMENDED)

- Apply by email crc@kalumburu.org
- Allow up to **10 business days processing**
- Provide names, travel dates, and vehicle details
- **\$80 per person** 15 years and under free (*subject to change*)
