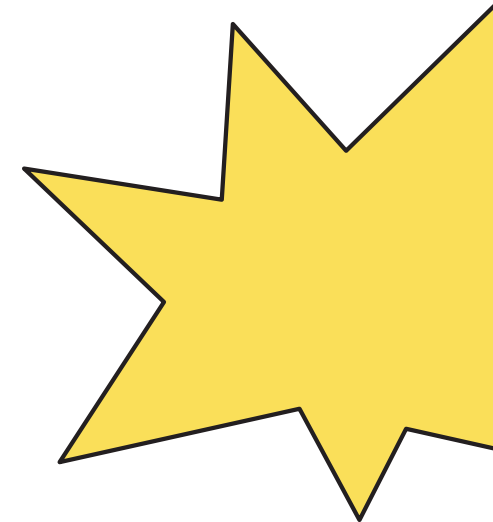

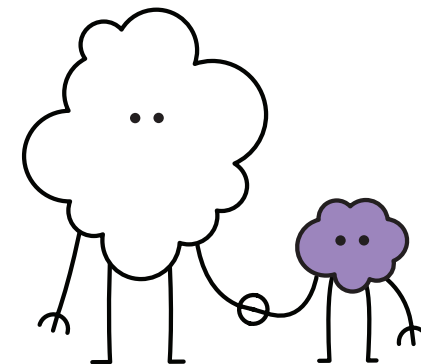

Put the screens away – we're on a mission to get you moving! You might find yourself doing some stretchy yoga or get your heart racing in the Superhero exercise class!

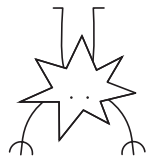

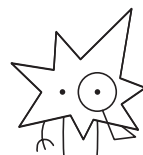
