## Jarrah & Wisps top tips:

## Depot Hill

Native shrubs flowering and looking great. Cowslip and sun orchids are on the main right hand walk trail leading to the trenches. Pink Everlastings have lost colour with the warmer days, and are setting seed.



## Coalseam Conservation park

Pink and white everlastings are losing colour and setting seed. The yellow pom poms are out in force. Lots of native shrubs flowering. Please drive to conditions.



## Mingenew Hill

Unfortunately the wild oats have really taken hold this year and lots of the pom poms have been eaten by caterpillars so aren't looking great. Still fabulous views of the town and surrounding farmland from the top.



## Recreation Centre

Lemon scented Sun orchids, & Ant orchids at the back of the hockey oval. Lots of other wildflowers and flowering shrubs out. Limited turning space, best to park at Netball Courts and walk up past the rocket.
