BUNDALONG TAVERN

Shipping container bar was painted at the Bundalong Tavern by Sobrane Simcock who also painted the Tungamah Silo Art, Meirlo Café in Numurkah and has now opened an art gallery at the Tungamah Hotel.

TUNGAMAH SILO

Western Australian street artist Sobrane Simcock was commissioned to paint the privately owned Tungamah Silos in 2018. This was the first silo to be painted in north-east Victoria, beginning this Silo Art Trail. Sobrane was the first Australian female silo artist. Stage two of the Tungamah Silo was completed in October 2019.



ST JAMES SILO

Painted by artist Tim Bowtell, the silos depict a mural of Sir George Coles, the founder of Coles supermarkets who was a local to the St James township. The silo bunkers at St James were built in 1943, with bushels of wheat originally delivered to the site via horse and cart; a motif that is displayed in the artwork.



DEVENISH SILO

This artwork, by artist Cam Scale, is a tribute to the men and women of the Devenish community who have enlisted in military service. The GrainCorp Devenish silos have long been a symbol of the prosperity of local grain production. That they now depict an aspect of military service provided by the community is a fitting link between the two.



GOORAMBAT SILO

The Goorambat community is very proud to have jimmy Dvate's artwork adorn the silos, Jimmy is passionate about conservation and is particularly keen to highlight the plight of endangered species. The barking owl is the most threatened owl in Victoria with Northeast Victoria a remaining stronghold for wild populations



GOORAMBAT UNITING CHURCH 'SOPHIA'

'Sophia' came into being during 2017 Wall to Wall Festival. Artist Adnate created this stunning mural to depict the female aspect of the Holy Spirit. Sophia by nature is wise, nurturing, comforting, inspirational and ever present. Open for viewing from 9am – 5pm daily or the phone number is on the door.



WINTON WETLAND'S WATER TANK

This stunning visual tribute was created during the 2016 Wall to Wall Festival by renowned street artist Guido Van Helten, the commission saw Guido incorporate portraits of three local volunteers, Colin Hooke from Chesney Vale Fire Brigade, Rovert Green of Taminick Fire Brigade and Danielle Spokes of Winton Fire Brigade.

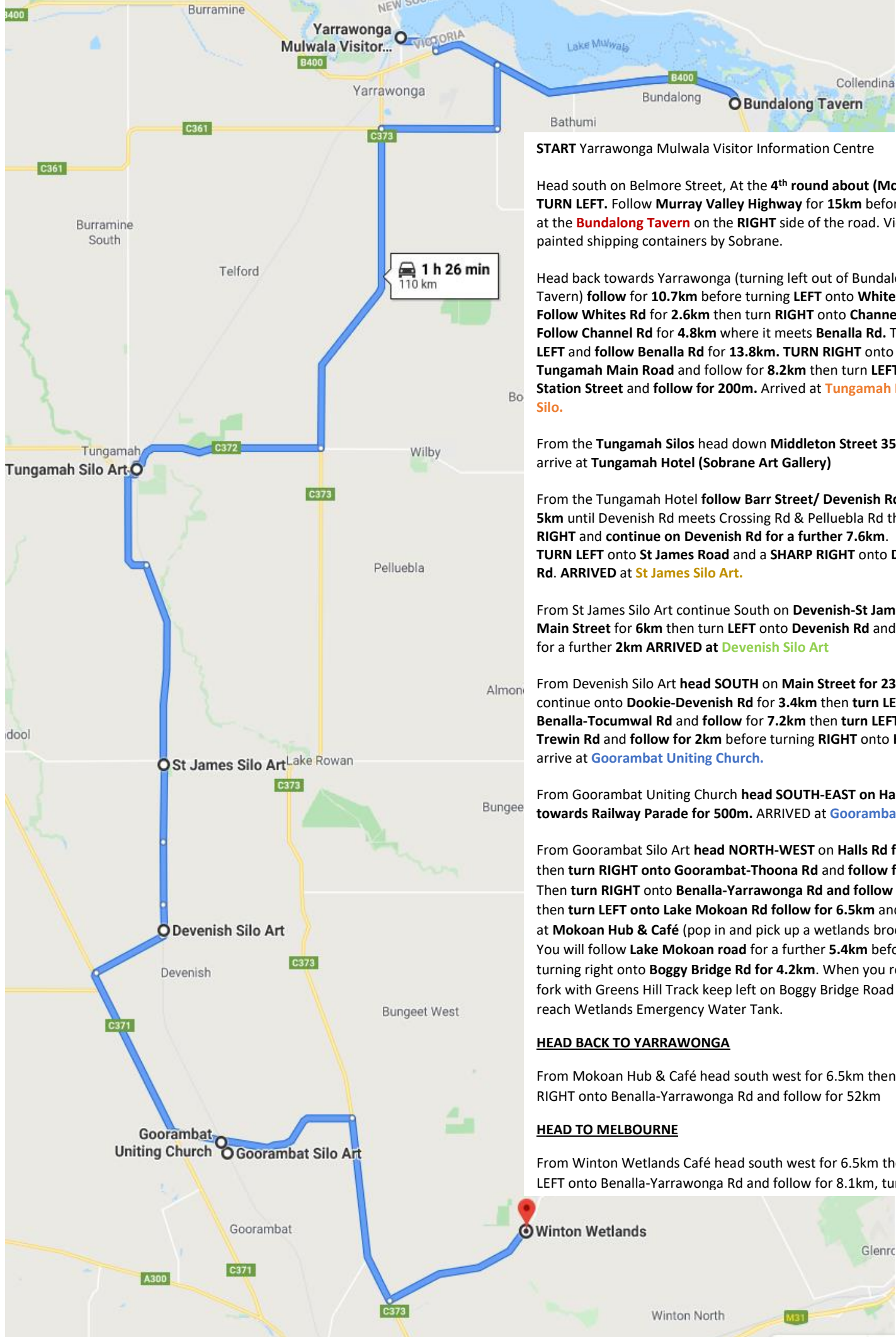

START Yarrowonga Mulwala Visitor Information Centre

Head south on Belmore Street, At the 4th round about (McDonalds) **TURN LEFT**. Follow **Murray Valley Highway** for 15km before arriving at the **Bundalong Tavern** on the **RIGHT** side of the road. View painted shipping containers by Sobrane.

Head back towards Yarrowonga (turning left out of Bundalong Tavern) **follow** for 10.7km before turning **LEFT** onto **Whites Rd**. **Follow Whites Rd** for 2.6km then turn **RIGHT** onto **Channel Rd**. **Follow Channel Rd** for 4.8km where it meets **Benalla Rd**. Then turn **LEFT** and **follow Benalla Rd** for 13.8km. **TURN RIGHT** onto **Tungamah Main Road** and follow for 8.2km then turn **LEFT** onto **Station Street** and **follow** for 200m. Arrived at **Tungamah Painted Silo**.

From the **Tungamah Silos** head down **Middleton Street** 350m and arrive at **Tungamah Hotel (Sobrane Art Gallery)**

From the Tungamah Hotel **follow Barr Street/ Devenish Rd EAST** for 5km until Devenish Rd meets Crossing Rd & Pelluebla Rd then **Keep RIGHT** and **continue on Devenish Rd** for a further 7.6km. **TURN LEFT** onto **St James Road** and a **SHARP RIGHT** onto **Devenish Rd**. **ARRIVED** at **St James Silo Art**.

From St James Silo Art continue South on **Devenish-St James Rd / Main Street** for 6km then turn **LEFT** onto **Devenish Rd** and **follow** for a further 2km **ARRIVED** at **Devenish Silo Art**

From Devenish Silo Art **head SOUTH** on **Main Street** for 230m then continue onto **Dookie-Devenish Rd** for 3.4km then **turn LEFT** onto **Benalla-Tocumwal Rd** and **follow** for 7.2km then **turn LEFT** onto **Trewin Rd** and **follow** for 2km before turning **RIGHT** onto **Halls Rd** & arrive at **Goorambat Uniting Church**.

From Goorambat Uniting Church **head SOUTH-EAST** on **Halls Rd** towards **Railway Parade** for 500m. **ARRIVED** at **Goorambat Silo Art**.

From Goorambat Silo Art **head NORTH-WEST** on **Halls Rd** for 550m then **turn RIGHT** onto **Goorambat-Thoona Rd** and **follow** for 6km. Then **turn RIGHT** onto **Benalla-Yarrowonga Rd** and **follow** for 7.6km then **turn LEFT** onto **Lake Mokoan Rd** **follow** for 6.5km and **ARRIVE** at **Mokoan Hub & Café** (pop in and pick up a wetlands brochure) You will follow **Lake Mokoan road** for a further 5.4km before turning right onto **Boggy Bridge Rd** for 4.2km. When you reach a fork with Greens Hill Track keep left on Boggy Bridge Road then reach Wetlands Emergency Water Tank.

HEAD BACK TO YARRAWONGA

From Mokoan Hub & Café head south west for 6.5km then Turn **RIGHT** onto **Benalla-Yarrowonga Rd** and follow for 52km

HEAD TO MELBOURNE

From Winton Wetlands Café head south west for 6.5km then Turn **LEFT** onto **Benalla-Yarrowonga Rd** and follow for 8.1km, turn **LEFT**
