POOL AVE TOILET BLOCK BY THE BANKS MURAL



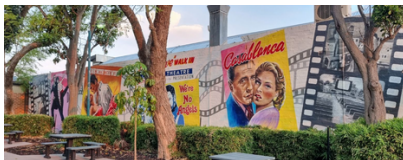
Federation Youth Council in conjunction with Federation Council have worked alongside Street Artist Samuel Hall to create a mural on the banks of Lake Mulwala at Apex Park. The mural tells a local story and educates youth and visitors on historic local story of the Mulwala area. Mulwala is the Bpangerang name for the White Bellied Sea Eagle, which is also represented in the mural design, which was passed to Council by the late Uncle Freddie Dowling.

TUNZAFUN CIRCUS MURAL

This Painted Mural is located at Rotary Park on Belmore Street Yarrawonga. Where 'The Grove Open Air Theatre' once stood from 1935 until the 1960's. The Artist Tim Bowtell's painted mural depicts old classic movie-style posters, black and white photos of the theatre, projector room, manager Don Forbes and the Usherettes.

Tungamah Silo

Western Australian street artist Sobrane Simcock was commissioned to paint the privately owned Tungamah Silos in 2018. This was the first silo to be painted in north-east Victoria, beginning this Silo Art Trail. Sobrane was the first Australian female silo artist. Stage two of the Tungamah Silo was completed in October 2019.

St James Silo

Painted by artist Tim Bowtell, the silos depict a mural of Sir George Coles, the founder of Coles supermarkets who was a local to the St James township. The silo bunkers at St James were built in 1943, with bushels of wheat originally delivered to the site via horse and cart; a motif that is displayed in the artwork.

Devenish Silo

This artwork, by Cam Scale, is a tribute to the men and women of the Devenish community who have enlisted in military service. The Grain Corp Devenish silos have long been a symbol of the prosperity of local grain production. That they now depicted an aspect of military service provided by the community is a fitting link between the two.

Goorambat Silo

The Goorambat community is very proud to have Jimmy Dvate's artwork adorn the silos. Jimmy is passionate about conservation and is particularly keen to highlight the plight of endangered species. The barking owl is the most threatened owl in Victoria with Northeast Victoria the remaining stronghold for wild populations.
